UPCOMING GAMES



Tuesday, Nov. 3, 2009 at Portland Trail Blazers (10 p.m.)

TV: SPSO ... Radio: 790 The Zone/XM 232

Atlanta visits Rose Garden for the only time this year in the first-of-two meetings with the Trail Blazers ... The Blazers come to Philips Arena on 11/16 to finish the season series ... The teams split last season's series at one game apiece, each winning at home ... Portland took a 108-98 decision on 2/20 before Atlanta enacted some revenge with a 98-80 win on 3/15 ... The Hawks have dropped their last two contests at Rose Garden ... Portland leads the all-time series 49-45, including a 32-15 home record.



Wednesday, Nov. 4, 2009 at Sacramento Kings (10 p.m.)

TV: SPSO ... Radio: 790 The Zone/XM 232

The Hawks head to ARCO Arena for the only time this year in the first-of-two contests with the Kings ... Sacramento visits Philips Arena on 1/20 to close-out the season series ... Atlanta swept last season's series 2-0, including a 105-100 road triumph on 2/18 ... The Hawks have won three straight against Sacramento ... The Kings leads the all-time series 152-145, including a 71-39 home mark.



Friday, Nov. 6, 2009 at Charlotte Bobcats (7 p.m.)

Atlanta finishes their four game road trip with a visit to Time Warner Cable Arena for a match-up with the Bobcats ... The teams will play three more times this year – 1/22 and 3/19 at Philips Arena and 4/6 in Charlotte ... The Hawks took last season's series 3-1, including two home wins (88-83 on 11/21 and 83-79 on 12/15) ... Atlanta also won 102-97 in Charlotte on 2/6 before dropping the finale 98-91 on 3/6 ... The Bobcats lead the all-time series 12-8 (8-2 at home).



Saturday, Nov. 7, 2009 vs. Denver Nuggets (7 p.m.)

TV: SPSO HD/NBATV... Radio: 790 The Zone/XM 232

The Hawks and Nuggets square-off in the first of two meetings this year and for the only time at Philips Arena ... The clubs play again on 12/23 in Denver ... The teams split last season's series at one game apiece, each winning at home ... Atlanta took a 109-91 decision on 12/29 and Nuggets won 110-109 on 2/25 ... The Hawks and Nuggets have split the series each of the last four seasons and Atlanta owns a two-game home win streak in the series ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 39-31, including a 28-6 home record.

NEWS & NOTES

* Josh Smith became the youngest player in NBA history to reach 900 career blocked shots on 10/30 vs. Washington, at 23 years, 329 days old. Shaquille O'Neal (24 years, 286 days) held the previous mark. Smith is now the youngest in league history to the 200, 300, 400, 500, 600, 700, 800 and 900 plateaus.

* Through three games, Al Horford ranks 2nd in the NBA in blocks (2.7) and 4th in rebounds (12.3). Josh Smith is t5th in steals (2.3) and t19th in assists (5.7). Joe Johnson ranks t10th in the league in scoring (23.0).

* Josh Smith dished out career assist no. 1000 in the Hawks' season opener against Indiana on 10/28.

* The Hawks downed the Pacers in the season opener, 120-109, scoring at least 120 in an opener for the first time since putting in 131 in a victory against New Jersey on 11/1/87. Atlanta currently sits at 5th in the league in scoring (110.0 ppg) and leads the NBA in free throw percentage (.843).

* The Hawks have forced 56 turnovers through their first three games, scoring 72 total points off of those miscues. On the flip side, Atlanta has committed just 44 turnovers, resulting in 51 opponent points.

* Maurice Evans will celebrate his 31st birthday on 11/8.
