UPCOMING GAMES



Thursday, Nov. 26, 2009 vs. Orlando Magic (8 p.m.)
TV: TNT ... Radio: 790 The Zone/XM 232

The Hawks and Magic square-off in the first-of-four games and the first-of-two at Philips Arena ... Atlanta visits Orlando on 1/9 and 1/30 before the Magic return on 3/24 ... Orlando took last season's series 3-1, winning the final three games, including both at Philips Arena ... The Hawks have dropped three straight at home to the Magic, with their last win coming on 3/22/08 (98-90) ... Orlando leads the all-time series 41-36, but Atlanta holds a 24-14 advantage in home games.



Friday, Nov. 27, 2009 at Philadelphia 76ers (7 p.m.)
TV: FSSO HD ... Radio: 790 The Zone/Sirius 91

Atlanta visits Philadelphia for the first-of-three games with the 76ers ... The teams meet again on 3/3 in Atlanta and 3/26 in Philadelphia ... The 76ers won last season's series 2-1, including the only home game (98-85 on 3/31/09), and now own a two-game win streak against the Hawks ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 153-151 (47-85 on the road).



Sunday, Nov. 29, 2009 at Detroit Pistons (1 p.m.)
TV: FSSO HD ... Radio: 790 The Zone/XM 232

The Hawks visit the Motor City for the first-of-four games with the Pistons and the first-of-two on the road ... The teams play again on 3/13 and 4/3 at Philips Arena, and 4/7 in Detroit ... The Hawks swept last season's series 3-0, including the only game in Detroit ... It was the first season sweep against the Pistons since the 1993-94 campaign ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 159-155, including a 78-67 road record.

* The entire roster of Atlanta Hawks players and coaching staff will tipoff the holiday season with a special Thanksgiving event at The Gateway Center on 11/24. Beginning at 4:00 p.m., Hawks players and coaches will serve Thanksgiving dinners with all the trimmings to residents of the facility, located in downtown Atlanta.

* Atlanta-native Josh Smith will host approximately 200 women and children from My Sister's House for a special Thanksgiving event on 11/25 beginning at 4:30 p.m. The festivities will take place on the Hawks Practice Court at Philips Arena. Smith will help serve a Thanksgiving meal, before mingling with guests and signing autographs.

NEWS & NOTES

* Tied for the NBA's best record at 11-3, the Hawks are off to their best start since a 12-2 opening to the 1997-98 campaign, when Atlanta finished at 50-32. It also ties for the second-best start in Atlanta history.

* The Hawks are a perfect 7-0 at Philips Arena this year and owns a nine-game home winning streak dating back to last season.

* Marvin Williams set a new career-high with 13 made FGs (13-19) vs. Houston on 11/20, finishing the night with a season-best 29 points and 9 rebounds. In that same game, Zaza Pachulia tied his career-high with 3 blocked shots.

* The Hawks are currently the NBA's best at scoring inside the paint, and are tallying 51.4 points per game. Atlanta is also third in fast break points (17.6 per game).

* Josh Smith has recorded all five of his double-doubles this season in the last seven games and is now tied for 14th in the NBA. Al Horford leads the team and ranks tied for fourth in the league with eight double-doubles.

* Jamal Crawford is averaging 16.7 points per game which is second among NBA players that have not started a game this season. Mavericks guard and former Hawk Jason Terry is the leader at 17.2 points per game.

* Mike Bibby suffered a sprained left ankle on 11/21 at New Orleans and is listed as day-to-day.

* The Hawks-Magic game on 11/26 features the Chick-fil-A® Family Night promotion where fans purchase four tickets and four Chick-fil-A® combo meal coupons starting at \$89. The Hawks will be wearing their new red second road uniform for the first time during the game. Visit www.hawks.com for more information.
