UPCOMING GAMES



Wednesday, Dec. 9, 2009 vs. Chicago Bulls (7 p.m.)
TV: FSSO HD/ESPN ... Radio: 790 The Zone/XM 232

The Hawks and Bulls meet for the first-of-four times this year and for the first-of-two in Atlanta ... The teams play again on 2/5 at Philips Arena, and 12/19 and 3/1 in Chicago ... Atlanta swept last season's series 3-0, including the only contest at Philips Arena (129-117 on 12/27) ... It was the Hawks' first ever season series sweep of the Bulls ... Atlanta currently has a four-game winning streak in the series, and has won three-straight at home ... Chicago leads the all-time series 110-96, with the Hawks holding a 56-44 advantage in home games.



Friday, Dec. 11, 2009 at Toronto Raptors (7 p.m.)
TV: SPSO ... Radio: 790 The Zone/Sirius 91

Atlanta heads north of the border for the first time this year in the second-of-four games with Toronto ... The Hawks took a 146-115 home decision in game one on 12/2, with nine players scoring in double-figures ... The Hawks have now won three straight games against the Raptors, including the last road game (118-110 on 4/7/09) ... The teams play again on 3/17 (in Toronto) and 4/9 (at Philips Arena) to finish the season series ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 29-25, including a 13-13 road mark.



Sunday, Dec. 13, 2009 vs. New Jersey Nets (5 p.m.)
TV: SPSO ... Radio: 790 The Zone/XM 232

The Hawks host New Jersey for the first time this year in the first-of-three games with the Nets ... The teams meet again on 1/6 (at Philips Arena) and 3/16 (in New Jersey) to close-out the season series ... The Nets took three-of-four versus the Hawks last season, with Atlanta winning the final game 105-88 at Philips Arena on 1/30 ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 79-63 (50-20 at home).
