### UPCOMING GAMES



**Monday, Jan. 11, 2010 at Boston Celtics (7:30 p.m.)**

**TV: SPSO HD/NBA TV ... Radio: 790 The Zone/XM 212**

The Hawks take on the Celtics for the second time in three games, and in the third-of-four meetings between the clubs this season ... Atlanta has taken both games thus far – a 97-86 win on 11/13 in Boston (Joe Johnson scored 24) and a 93-85 victory on Friday at Philips Arena, behind Jamal Crawford's 18 points off the bench ... The teams play again on 1/29 at Philips Arena to finish the season series. The Hawks are 126-216 all-time against the Celtics, including a 32-110 road mark.



**Wednesday, Jan. 13, 2010 vs. Washington Wizards (7 p.m.)**

**TV: SPSO HD ... Radio: 790 The Zone/Sirius 90**

Washington comes to Philips Arena for the second-and-final time in the second-of-four games against the Hawks ... Atlanta heads to the nation's capital on 2/6 and 4/10 to close-out the season series ... The Hawks took a 100-89 home decision in game one (10/30), behind 20 points from Josh Smith ... Gilbert Arenas put in 23 points to lead the Wizards ... The Hawks have a six-game winning streak in the series, including three straight at Philips Arena ... The all-time series is deadlocked at 132 wins apiece, with the Hawks leading 84-42 in home games.



**Friday, Jan. 15, 2010 vs. Phoenix Suns (8 p.m.)**

**TV: SPSO HD/ESPN ... Radio: 790 The Zone/Sirius 90**

Atlanta hosts Phoenix for the only time this year in the first-of-two contests between the clubs ... The Hawks visit the Suns on 2/19 to close-out the season series ... Phoenix swept both games last year and has won three-in-a-row against Atlanta overall ... The Hawks' last win versus the Suns was a 105-96 home decision on 11/7/07 ... Phoenix leads the all-time series 62-46, with the Hawks holding a 28-23 advantage in home games.

### NEWS & NOTES

\* On 1/5 the Hawks waived forward Othello Hunter. The two-year veteran out of Ohio St. appeared in 7 games this season, and averaged 1.6 ppg and 1.7 rpg in 4.7 mpg (.333 FG%, .750 FT%). He played in 16 games with Atlanta last season as a rookie, and had four playoff appearances. Overall, in 23 career regular season games with the Hawks, Hunter compiled 1.4 ppg and 1.6 rpg in 5.4 mpg (.469 FG%, .333 FT%).

\* Jamal Crawford recorded the 21<sup>st</sup> 4-point play of his career vs. Boston (1/8), and now trails all-time leader Reggie Miller by 3.

\* Several Hawks are closing in on statistical milestones, including Joe Johnson who is 2 3FGs short of 1000 for his career. Mike Bibby needs 14 FGs for 5000 and Joe Smith needs 6 assists for 1000. Additionally, Josh Smith needs 4 steals to tie Spud Webb for 10<sup>th</sup> on the Hawks' all-time list (499).

\* The Hawks-Suns game on 1/15 at Philips Arena will now be broadcast on ESPN (8 p.m.), in addition to SportSouth HD and 790 The Zone.

### THIS WEEK IN HAWKS HISTORY

**January 16, 1972** – Pete Maravich scores 50 points in Atlanta's 124-116 home win over Philadelphia. It is tied for the 9<sup>th</sup> highest scoring game in Hawks history. Exactly one year later, Maravich put his name in the record books again by dishing out 18 assists in Atlanta's 130-129 home win over Detroit in overtime. It is tied for the 5<sup>th</sup> highest assist total in club history.
