### UPCOMING GAMES



**Monday, Jan. 25, 2010 at Houston Rockets (8:30 p.m.)**

**TV: SPSO HD ... Radio: 790 The Zone/Sirius 121**

Atlanta visits Houston for the only time this year in the second-of-two games with the Rockets ... The Hawks took game one, 105-103, on 11/20 at Philips Arena behind 29 points from Marvin Williams (career-high 13 made FGs) and 21 from Jamal Crawford ... Carl Landry paced the Rockets with 18 ... Atlanta has now won two-straight in the series but has dropped 10-in-row on the road ... The Hawks' last win in Houston was a 93-87 decision on 2/25/99 ... The all-time series is knotted at 68 apiece, with the Rockets holding a 48-19 advantage in home games.



**Wednesday, Jan. 27, 2010 at San Antonio Spurs (8:30 p.m.)**

**TV: SPSO HD ... Radio: 790 The Zone/XM 236**

The Hawks head to San Antonio for the only time this year in the first-of-two games with the Spurs ... The clubs meet again on 3/21 at Philips Arena to finish the season series ... San Antonio swept last season's series 2-0 and has won six-straight overall ... The Spurs have also taken 11-in-a-row at home ... Atlanta's last win against the Spurs was a 94-84 triumph on 12/10/05 and their last road win occurred on 2/15/97 (109-89) ... San Antonio leads the all-time series 39-35, including a 25-12 home record.



**Friday, Jan. 29, 2010 vs. Boston Celtics (7:30 p.m.)**

**TV: SPSO HD/NBA TV ... Radio: 790 The Zone/XM 234**

Atlanta hosts Boston for the second time this year in the fourth-and-final meeting between the clubs ... The Hawks will be looking for their first season sweep of Boston since 1998-99 when they went 3-0 and their first 4-0 sweep since 1995-96 ... Atlanta has posted road wins of 97-86 on 11/13 behind 24 points from Joe Johnson and 102-96 on 1/11 (Johnson had 36) ... The Hawks also took a 93-85 decision at Philips Arena on 1/8, with Jamal Crawford leading the way with 18 points ... The Celtics lead the all-time series 216-127, with the Hawks having an 80-77 edge in home games.



**Saturday, Jan. 30, 2010 at Orlando Magic (7 p.m.)**

**TV: SPSO HD/NBA TV ... Radio: 790 The Zone/XM 232**

The Hawks go to Orlando for the second time this year in the third-of-four games with the Magic ... Orlando visits Philips Arena on 3/24 to close-out the season series ... The Magic sport a 2-0 record against the Hawks so far this year – winning 93-76 at Philips Arena on 11/26 and 113-81 in Orlando on 1/9 – and have won five straight overall (two-in-a-row at home) ... Atlanta's last win in the series was a 99-85 road decision on 10/29/08 ... Orlando leads the all-time series 43-36 (28-12 at home).

\* On 1/18 Al Horford joined a group of professional athletes helping to provide emergency medical supplies and essentials to those recently affected by the deadly earthquake in Haiti through "Athletes Relief Fund for Haiti", created by former NBA All Star Alonzo Mourning. Horford donated an entire game check to the effort.

### NEWS & NOTES

\* With a 28-14 record, the Hawks are currently leading their Division for the first time this late in the season since April 28, 1999, when they were tied for the Central Division lead with Indiana at 29-17. The 28-14 record is tied for the third-best through 42 games in Atlanta history.

\* Josh Smith recorded his 500<sup>th</sup> career steal against Charlotte on 1/22, moving past Spud Webb for 10<sup>th</sup> place on the Hawks' all-time list. He is now at 501 for his career and is 14 thefts behind Jon Koncak for 9<sup>th</sup> place.

\* Several Hawks players currently rank among the NBA's best in a number of statistical categories: Joe Johnson is 11<sup>th</sup> in scoring and FGM, 17<sup>th</sup> in 3FGM, 18<sup>th</sup> in minutes, 23<sup>rd</sup> in assists and 13<sup>th</sup> in FT% ... Jamal Crawford is 13<sup>th</sup> in scoring, 15<sup>th</sup> in 3FGM and 20<sup>th</sup> in FT% ... Al Horford is 5<sup>th</sup> in FG%, 13<sup>th</sup> in rebounding, 14<sup>th</sup> in offensive rebounding, 14<sup>th</sup> in double-doubles and 20<sup>th</sup> in blocks ... Josh Smith is 4<sup>th</sup> in blocks, 20<sup>th</sup> in steals, 24<sup>th</sup> in FG%, 26<sup>th</sup> in rebounding and 38<sup>th</sup> in assists ... Mike Bibby is 4<sup>th</sup> in assist/turnover ratio, 26<sup>th</sup> in 3FG%, 28<sup>th</sup> in assists and 31<sup>st</sup> in 3FGM ... Marvin Williams is 37<sup>th</sup> in FT%. \* The Hawks signed Mario West to a second 10-day contract on 1/22. In four games with Atlanta this season, West has averaged 1.3 points and 2.3 rebounds (.667 FG%, 1-1 FTs).

\* Three Hawks are closing in milestone numbers – Josh Smith is 13 blocks away from 1000 for his career, Mike Bibby needs 4 made FGs for 5000 and Joe Smith is 4 assists short of 1000.

**January 31, 2001** – Dikembe Mutombo pulls down 29 rebounds (12 offensive, 17 defensive) in the Hawks' 102-97 home win over Toronto. It is the third best single game rebounding performance since the team moved to Atlanta.
