UPCOMING GAMES



Monday, Jan. 4, 2010 at Miami Heat (7:30 p.m.)

TV: SPSO HD/NBA TV ... Radio: 790 The Zone/XM 211

Atlanta visits Miami for the first time this year in the second-of-four games with the Heat ... The Hawks took a 105-90 home decision on 11/18 in game one, thanks to 30 points from Joe Johnson, and double-doubles from Josh Smith (16 points/14 rebounds) and Al Horford (16 points/12 rebounds) ... Michael Beasley paced the Heat with 21 points ... Atlanta has now won three straight games in the regular season series (all at home), but the Heat won the last meeting in Miami (95-79 on 1/26/09) ... The teams play again on 2/10 at Philips Arena and 3/6 in Miami to finish the season series ... The Heat lead the all-time series 42-38, including a 29-11 home mark.



Wednesday, Jan. 6, 2010 vs. New Jersey Nets (7 p.m.)

TV: FSSO HD ... Radio: 790 The Zone/Sirius 90

Atlanta hosts the Nets for the second-and-final time this year in the second-of-three meetings between the teams ... The Hawks visit New Jersey on 3/16 to close-out the season series ... Atlanta took a 130-107 decision at Philips Arena in game one (12/13), behind 22 points from Maurice Evans, and 21 points and 10 assists from Joe Johnson ... Devin Harris led the Nets with 23 points ... Atlanta has now won two-straight against the Nets (both at home) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 80-63 (51-20 at home).



Friday, Jan. 8, 2010 vs. Boston Celtics (8 p.m.)

TV: ESPN ... Radio: 790 The Zone/XM 212

The Hawks host the Celtics for the first time this year in the second-of-four games between the teams ... Atlanta took the first game (11/13) in Boston, 97-86, behind 24 points from Joe Johnson and Al Horford's double-double (12 points/13 rebounds) ... Paul Pierce's 24 led the Celtics ... The win snapped a seven-game Celtics winning streak against the Hawks, including five-in-a-row in Beantown ... Boston still owns a three-game win streak at Philips Arena ... The teams play again on 1/11 (in Boston) and 1/29 at Philips Arena to finish the season series ... The Celtics lead the all-time series 216-125, but the Hawks hold a 79-77 advantage in home games.



Saturday, Jan. 9, 2010 at Orlando Magic (7 p.m.)

TV: FSSO HD ... Radio: 790 The Zone/XM 232

The Hawks visit Orlando for the first time this year in the second-of-four games between the clubs ... The Magic came out victorious in the first meeting, 93-76, on Thanksgiving Day at Philips Arena ... Dwight Howard led the way with 22 points and 17 rebounds ... Joe Johnson tallied 22 for the Hawks and Josh Smith posted 13 points and 13 boards ... The teams play again on 1/30 (in Orlando) and 3/24 at Philips Arena to end the season series ... The Magic have a three-game win streak against the Hawks, including the last meeting in Orlando (121-87 on 1/9/09) ... Orlando leads the all-time series 42-36, including a 27-12 home record.

* Tickets are now available for Full Court Fest, the Atlanta Hawks Foundation's annual fundraising event. This year's festivities will be held on 1/23 at Ventanas on the rooftop of the Park Pavilion Building in downtown Atlanta. The entire roster of Hawks players and coaches will be in attendance. Tickets cost \$125 for the general public and \$100 for season ticket holders, with all proceeds benefiting the Hawks Foundation and its numerous philanthropic endeavors. More information about this event will be released in the near future.

* The finals of the Atlanta Hawks Poetry Slam will be held on 1/5 at the Hard Rock Café in downtown Atlanta (215 Peachtree Street, Atlanta, GA 30303). Fifteen area high school students will compete for a first prize of a laptop computer (courtesy of Wal-Mart), an autographed Hawks jersey, four game tickets and Hard Rock merchandise. The winner will also perform his or her poem at an upcoming Hawks home game. The event begins at 6:30 p.m.

* NBA Fit Week, a new initiative which encourages being active, eating right and making healthy choices, runs from 1/4-1/11. Atlanta's NBA Fit Day is slated for 1/10 from 3-5 p.m. One Hundred children and adults have been invited to participate in the NBA Fit Day Clinic located at Corpus Christi Catholic Church (600 Mountain View Dr., Stone Mountain, GA 30083). The clinic will consist of information and activity stations hosted by NBA Staff, members of the A-Town Dancers, former Hawks guard Charlie Criss, and the Hawks Basketball Development department. Atlanta will also be the host city to hold the NBA Fit Challenge regional round consisting of 32 winners from local contests and locations. Winners of the NBA Fit Challenge Regional Competition will compete in the NBA Fit Challenge Finals in Dallas, TX during the NBA All-Star Weekend.

NEWS & NOTES

* Mike Bibby became the 49th player in NBA history to reach the 5000 career assist plateau vs. New York on 1/1.

* Attendance at the Hawks-Cavaliers game on 12/29 was 20,150, the second largest crowd for any Hawks game at Philips Arena, and the largest regular season total ever.

* Al Horford tied a career-high with 11 FGM vs. New York on 1/1. He finished the night with 22 points and a season-high-tying 19 rebounds.

* Joe Johnson is one of three NBA players (LeBron James and Dwyane Wade) averaging at least 20.0 points, 5.0 rebounds and 5.0 assists.

* The Hawks-Nets game on 1/6 features the Aaron's Lucky Dog Wednesdays promotion where upper level seats are available for \$15 (excluding Metro PCS Unlimited Eat Seats and \$10 locations). Visit www.hawks.com for more information.
