### UPCOMING GAMES



**Tuesday, Feb. 2, 2010 at Oklahoma City Thunder (8 p.m.)**  
**TV: FSSO HD ... Radio: 790 The Zone/XM 236**

Atlanta visits Oklahoma City for the only time this year in the second-and-final meeting between the clubs ... The Thunder took game one, 94-91, at Philips Arena on 1/18, behind Kevin Durant's 29 points ... Joe Johnson had 23 points for the Hawks, while Josh Smith (18 points/12 rebounds) and Al Horford (13 points/10 rebounds) each had double-doubles ... Atlanta has taken two straight games in Oklahoma City ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 61-55 (23-33 on the road).



**Wednesday, Feb. 3, 2010 vs. L.A. Clippers (7 p.m.)**  
**TV: FSSO HD ... Radio: 790 The Zone/XM 232**

The Clippers come to Philips Arena for the only time this year in the first-of-two games with the Hawks ... Atlanta heads to Los Angeles on 2/17 to finish the season series ... The teams split two games last season, each winning on the road ... L.A. took a 121-97 decision at Philips Arena on 2/7 in the last meeting between the clubs ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 66-36, including a 38-13 home mark.



**Friday, Feb. 5, 2010 vs. Chicago Bulls (8 p.m.)**  
**TV: ESPN ... Radio: 790 The Zone/XM 235**

The Hawks host the Bulls for the second-and-final time this year in the third-of-four games between the clubs ... Atlanta goes to the Windy City on 3/1 to close-out the season series ... The teams have split two games so far, each winning at home ... The Hawks won 118-83 on 12/9 thanks to 29 points from Jamal Crawford ... The Bulls evened things up with a 101-98 win on 12/19 behind Derrick Rose's 32 ... Joe Johnson led all scorers with 40 and Al Horford had a double-double (15 points/12 boards) ... Atlanta has won four straight against Chicago at Philips Arena ... The Bulls lead the all-time series 111-97, with the Hawks holding a 57-44 advantage in home games.



**Saturday, Feb. 6, 2010 at Washington Wizards (7 p.m.)**  
**TV: SP50 ... Radio: 790 The Zone**

Atlanta heads to the nation's capital for the first time this year in the third-of-four games against the Wizards ... The Hawks are 2-0 versus Washington (both at home) so far and have taken seven straight overall ... The Wizards' last win was a 102-98 (OT) triumph on 1/11/08 ... In the Hawks' 100-89 win on 10/30, Josh Smith scored 20 points and Al Horford posted a double-double with 10 points and 12 boards ... Joe Johnson led the way with 24 points in Atlanta's 94-82 victory on 1/13, while Josh Smith had a double-double (10 points/12 rebounds) ... Three Wizards posted point/rebound double-doubles, led by Antawn Jamison's 25 and 19 ... Atlanta goes back to DC, where they have won four-in-a-row, on 4/10 to finish the season series ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 133-132 but are 41-85 on the road.

\* The Atlanta Hawks Foundation has announced the opening of its 2010 charitable grant cycle. From 2/1 – 3/31/10, the Hawks Foundation will be accepting grant applications for \$50,000 in available funds from non-profit organizations in three focus areas – Education, Health & Wellness, and Recreation. Last year, the Foundation awarded grants to Girls On The Run, the Ferst Foundation for Childhood Literacy, the North Metro Miracle League and the Ryan Cameron Foundation. The Hawks Foundation makes grants to non-profit, tax-exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Award notifications will be made in June 2009. \* The Hawks will celebrate Black History Month by honoring several prominent Atlanta-area leaders including Ken Hudson (Basketball Hall of Fame referee), Thomas G. Sampson (Co-founder and managing partner of Thomas, Kennedy, Sampson & Patterson, Atlanta's oldest minority-owned law firm), the Spelman College "Spellbots" (the school's robotics team), the Youth Ensemble of Atlanta (an organization which provides young people with free performing arts training), and Xernona Clayton (President and CEO of the Trumpet Awards Foundation, Inc. and Creator and Executive Producer of the Foundation's Trumpet Awards). More information regarding Black History Month will be released this week.

### NEWS & NOTES

\* For the first time in 12 years, the Atlanta Hawks will have two players on the All-Star team, as the NBA announced on 1/28 that guard Joe Johnson and forward/center Al Horford have been named as reserves to the 2010 NBA Eastern Conference All-Star squad. It is Johnson's fourth consecutive selection and Horford's first. The game takes place on Sunday, February 14 at Cowboys Stadium in Arlington, TX, with coverage on TNT beginning at 7 p.m.

\* With 999 career blocks, Josh Smith is primed to become the youngest player in NBA history to reach the 1,000 plateau (topping Benoit Benjamin – 25 yrs/128 days). He would also become the third Hawk to reach the milestone, joining Tree Rollins and Dilembe Mutombo.

\* Joe Johnson needs 4 3FGs to tie Jason Terry for second on the Hawks' all-time list with 648. Josh Smith needs 5 steals to tie Jon Koncak for ninth in Hawks history with 515.

\* The Hawks signed Mario West for the remainder of the season on 2/1. West is averaging 0.9 points and 1.6 rebounds in 8 games with Atlanta since signing the first-of-two 10-day contracts on 1/12.

### THIS WEEK IN HAWKS HISTORY

**February 5, 1972** – Pete Maravich scores 50 points in Atlanta's 120-117 home win over Cleveland. It is tied for the ninth-highest, single-game scoring effort in franchise history. Maravich's 20 made field goals (20-27) are tied for sixth on the club's all-time list.
