Monday, Feb. 22, 2010 at Utah Jazz (9 p.m.)
TV: SPSO ... Radio: 790 The Zone/XM 235

The Hawks and Jazz match up for the second-and-final time this year and for the only time in Salt Lake City ... Atlanta took game one, 96-83, on 12/18 ... Josh Smith led the way with 16 points while Andrei Kirilenko had 13 for Utah ... It was the Hawks' second straight win over the Jazz ... Utah has won 15 consecutive games at home in the series ... The Hawks last victory in Utah was on 2/13/93 (121-112) ... The Jazz lead the all-time series 47-38, including a 31-11 home record.



Wednesday, Feb. 24, 2010 vs. Minnesota Timberwolves (7 p.m.)
TV: SPSO HD ... Radio: 790 The Zone/Sirius 91

Minnesota visits Philips Arena for the only time this year in the second-and-final meeting with the Hawks ... Atlanta posted a 112-87 road win in the first game (12/22) behind 26 points from Jamal Crawford and Al Horford's double-double (16 points/11 rebounds) ... Jonny Flynn tallied 16 points for the Timberwolves and Kevin Love recorded 15 points and 19 boards ... The Hawks currently own a six-game winning streak against the T-Wolves overall and have also taken six straight at Philips Arena ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 24-15 (14-5 at home).



Friday, Feb. 26, 2010 vs. Dallas Mavericks (7 p.m.)
TV: ESPN ... Radio: 790 The Zone/Sirius 91

Atlanta hosts Dallas for the only time this year in the second-and-final meeting between the clubs ... The Hawks won the first contest, 80-75, on 12/5 behind Joe Johnson's 31 points ... Dirk Nowitzki tallied 32 to lead all scorers ... The win was Atlanta's second-in-a-row against Dallas ... The Hawks have also won two-straight at Philips Arena in the series ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 31-27, including a 17-11 home mark.



Sunday, Feb. 28, 2010 vs. Milwaukee Bucks (6 p.m.)
TV: SPSO HD... Radio: 790 The Zone/XM 232

The Hawks and Bucks meet for the first-of-three games this year and for the only time at Philips Arena ... Atlanta visits Milwaukee on 3/22 and 4/12 to finish the season series ... The Hawks won last year's series 3-1, including both home contests ... Atlanta has won five straight at Philips Arena against the Bucks ... Milwaukee leads the all-time series 95-90, with the Hawks holding a 60-34 advantage in home games.

- * Jamal Crawford and Joe Johnson both hit milestone numbers at Golden State on 2/21. Crawford reached the 10,000 career point plateau, while Johnson dished out his 3000th career assist.
- * Josh Smith is currently the only player in the league averaging at least 15.0 points, 8.0 rebounds and 4.0 assists. Smith is putting up 15.4 points, 8.6 boards and 4.0 assists, to go along with 2.1 blocks and 1.6 steals.
- * The Hawks vs. Mavericks game on 2/26 at Philips Arena will tipoff at 7 p.m. and be televised on ESPN. The game was originally scheduled for an 8 p.m. tip.
- * Joe Johnson is averaging 23.0 points, while hitting .500 FG%, .469 3FG% and .862 FT% in the month of February (8 games).
