Tuesday, Feb. 9, 2010 at Memphis Grizzlies (8 p.m.)

The Hawks and Grizzlies meet for the second-and-final time this season, in the only matchup in Memphis ... On 12/16 at Philips Arena, Atlanta won, 110-97, as Joe Johnson (26 points) led five Hawks in double-figures ... Sam Young led Memphis with 20 points ... The win was the Hawks' fourth straight at home over the Grizzlies ... Atlanta has taken two-of-the-last-three matchups in Memphis ... The Hawks hold an 18-10 advantage in the all-time series (6-7 on the road).



Wednesday, Feb. 10, 2010 vs. Miami Heat (7 p.m.)

The Heat visit Atlanta for the second-and-final time this year in the third-of-four meetings between the clubs ... The Hawks go to Miami on 3/6 to finish the season series ... The teams have split two games so far, each winning at home ... The Hawks took game one, 105-90, on 11/18 behind 30 points from Joe Johnson, and double-doubles from Josh Smith (16 points/14 rebounds) and Al Horford (16 points/12 rebounds) ... Michael Beasley had 21 points for the Heat ... Miami evened things up with a 92-75 triumph on 1/4 thanks to 28 points from Dwyane Wade and Beasley's 22 ... Jamal Crawford paced the Hawks with 23 off the bench ... The Heat lead the all-time series 43-38, with Atlanta holding a 27-13 advantage in home games.

* The Hawks are celebrating Black History Month by honoring several prominent Atlanta-area leaders including Ken Hudson (second African-American game official in NBA history), Thomas G. Sampson (Co-founder and managing partner of Thomas, Kennedy, Sampson & Tompkins, Atlanta's oldest minority-owned law firm), the Spelman College "Spellbots" (the school's robotics team), the Youth Ensemble of Atlanta (an organization which provides young people with free performing arts training), Dr. Beverly Hall (Superintendent of Atlanta Public Schools) and Xernona Clayton (President and CEO of the Trumpet Awards Foundation, Inc.).

NEWS & NOTES

* Joe Johnson has been selected to his fourth consecutive Eastern Conference All-Star team, while Al Horford earned his first trip to the midseason classic. The 2010 NBA All-Star game will be played on 2/14 at Cowboys Stadium in Arlington, TX. Johnson will also participate in the Haier Shooting Stars competition on 2/13 as part of NBA All-Star Saturday Night, joining former Hawks star Steve Smith and Atlanta Dream guard Angel McCoughtry representing Team Atlanta.

* On 2/3 against the Clippers, Jamal Crawford set the NBA career record for four-point plays (24), according to Harvey Pollack's NBA statistical yearbook, surpassing Reggie Miller's old record of 23.

* On 2/2 at Oklahoma City, Josh Smith (at age 24 years/59 days) became the youngest player in NBA history to reach the 1,000 career block plateau, topping Benoit Benjamin (25 years/128 days).

* Joe Johnson moved past Jason Terry into 2nd place on the Hawks all-time 3FGs made list on 2/3 against the Clippers (now at 652).

* The Hawks-Wizards game scheduled for 2/6 was postponed due to severe weather conditions in the Washington DC area. The date for the rescheduled game will be announced at a later time.

* Josh Smith recorded his second career triple-double in Atlanta's 91-81 win over Chicago on 2/5. Smith finished the night with 18 points, 14 rebounds and a career-high-tying 10 assists.

* The Hawks-Heat game on 2/10 features the Aaron's Lucky Dog Wednesdays promotion where upper level seats are available for \$15 (excluding Metro PCS Unlimited Eat Seats and \$10 locations).

THIS WEEK IN HAWKS HISTORY

February 11, 1970 – The Hawks tie the franchise record for points in a game in a 155-131 road win over San Diego. The record was originally set by the St. Louis Hawks on Jan. 24, 1960 against the Knicks.
