UPCOMING GAMES



Monday, Mar. 22, 2010 at Milwaukee Bucks (8 p.m.)
TV: SPSO HD ... Radio: 790 The Zone/Sirius 90

Atlanta visits Milwaukee for the first time this year in the second-of-three games between the teams ... The Hawks took a 106-102 home decision on 2/28 behind 24 points from Joe Johnson and double-doubles from Josh Smith (22 points/15 rebounds) and Al Horford (17 points/10 boards) ... John Salmons led the Bucks with 32 points ... Atlanta returns to Milwaukee on 4/12 to finish the season series ... The Hawks have won two-straight over the Bucks, including their last visit to Milwaukee on 4/8/09 (113-105) ... The Bucks lead the all-time series 95-91, including a 60-34 home mark.



Wednesday, Mar. 24, 2010 vs. Orlando Magic (7 p.m.)
TV: SPSO HD ... Radio: 790 The Zone/XM 232

The Hawks host the Magic for the second time in the fourth-and-final meeting between the clubs ... Orlando is 3-0 against Atlanta this year, including a 96-73 win at Philips Arena on Thanksgiving Day ... Joe Johnson led the Hawks with 22 points while Dwight Howard had 22 points and 17 rebounds for Orlando ... The Magic also took both games in Orlando, 113-81 on 1/9 with seven players scoring in double-figures, and 104-86 on 1/30 behind Howard's 31 points and 19 boards ... Johnson and Jamal Crawford each 19 points for Atlanta ... The Magic have six-in-a-row in the series, including four-straight at Philips Arena ... Orlando leads the all-time series 44-36, with the Hawks holding a 24-15 advantage in home games.



Friday, Mar. 26, 2010 at Philadelphia 76ers (7 p.m.)
TV: SPSO ... Radio: 790 The Zone/Sirius 125

Atlanta heads to Philadelphia for the second time in the third-and-final game between the teams ... The Hawks are 2-0 against the 76ers this season, posting a 100-86 road win on 11/27 and a 112-93 home triumph on 3/3 ... Three Hawks went for 20 points in game one – Jamal Crawford (24), Mike Bibby (21) and Josh Smith (20), while Thaddeus Young led the Sixers with 22 ... Marvin Williams led Atlanta with 21 points in game two and Crawford added 20 ... Louis Williams led all scorers with 30 ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 155-151, with Philly holding a 85-48 lead in home games.



Sunday, Mar. 28, 2010 vs. Indiana Pacers (3:30 p.m.)
TV: SPSO HD ... Radio: 790 The Zone/XM 234

The Pacers come to Philips Arena for the second time in the third-and-final game with the Hawks ... Atlanta is 2-0 against Indiana this season, winning 120-109 at home on 10/28 and recording a 110-98 road triumph on 12/26 ... Joe Johnson scored 25 points in game one, and Al Horford had 24 points and 16 rebounds ... Danny Granger led all scorers with 31 ... Horford (25 points/19 boards), Johnson (24 points) and Josh Smith (22 points) paced the Hawks in game two ... Troy Murphy (19 points/12 rebounds) and Tyler Hansbrough (19 points/11 boards) led the Pacers ... Atlanta has won five-in-row against Indiana and has also won the last five at Philips Arena ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 84-73 (52-25 at home).

NEWS & NOTES

* Joe Smith played in his 1000th career game on 3/16 in New Jersey. The 15-year veteran became the 11th active player to do so, and the 93rd player in league history to reach the milestone.

* Jamal Crawford poured in a game-high 33 points in 37 minutes on 3/17 in Toronto. It was just the 14th time since the 1976-77 season that a Hawk has had a game of 30-or-more off the bench, and ties the fourth-highest total a Hawk has scored off the bench during that time.

* Joe Johnson ranks 11th in the NBA in scoring (21.4), made FGs (563) and minutes (38.2), 25th in made 3FGs (110), t26th in assists (4.8) and 37th in FT% (.825). Josh Smith is 5th in the league in blocks (2.03), 10th in steals (1.72), 18th in efficiency rating (22.3), t21st in rebounding (8.8), 24th in double-doubles (24), 25th in FG% (.505), 32nd assists (4.3) and 40th in minutes (35.3). Al Horford ranks 7th in FG% (.557), t12th in rebounding (9.6), 16th in double-doubles (30) and 30th in blocks (1.10). Jamal Crawford is 7th in made 3FGs (135), 22nd in FT% (.848) and 31st in scoring (17.9). Mike Bibby sits at 6th in A/TO ratio (3.46), t34th in assists (4.1) and t38th in 3FG% (.387), and Marvin Williams is t40th in FT% (.822).

* Atlanta's 119-114 OT triumph over the Spurs on 3/21 saw the Hawks rally from a 14-point hole, tying the largest deficit the Hawks have overcome to record a win this season (done twice previously).

* Joe Johnson needs 2 made field goals to become the 10th player to have 3000 in a Hawks uniform.

* Al Horford pulled down a career-best 9 offensive rebounds versus San Antonio on 3/21. He finished the game with 22 points and 18 total boards.

* Marvin Williams made his 1500th career field goal versus San Antonio on 3/21.
