#### PLAYOFF SERIES RECAP

The Hawks hold a 2-1 lead in their best-of-seven first round playoff series with Milwaukee ... Atlanta took a pair of 10-point wins (102-92 on 4/17 and 96-86 on 4/20) at Philips Arena to open the series before dropping a 107-89 decision at the Bradley Center in game three on 4/24 ... Joe Johnson is averaging 24.7 points to lead Atlanta, while Josh Smith is posting a double-double with 13.3 points and 12.0 rebounds (grabbing at least 10 boards in all three games) ... Other Hawks scoring in double-figures include Al Horford (15.0), Mike Bibby (11.7), Jamal Crawford (11.0) and Marvin Williams (10.3) ... John Salmons (19.7 points) and Brandon Jennings (18.7) are leading the Bucks ... Milwaukee hit a combined 10-44 (.227) from three-point range in games 1 and 2, before knocking down 10-23 (.435) triples in game 3 ... Atlanta made 6-11 three's (.545) in game one but has gone 6-26 since (.231) ... Milwaukee's bench has outscored their Atlanta counterparts in each of the three games by a combined count of 112-62 (26-22, 40-7, 46-33).

#### REGULAR SEASON SERIES

The Hawks and Bucks match-up in the playoffs after meeting three times during the regular season ... Atlanta won the season series 2-1, including a 106-102 OT home win on 2/28 ... The teams split two games in Milwaukee, with the Bucks winning 98-95 (3/22) and the Hawks taking a 104-96 decision (4/12) ... Joe Johnson averaged 27.3 points against the Bucks during the regular season, while Jamal Crawford put in 17.5 ... Al Horford (14.0 points/11.3 rebounds) and Josh Smith (14.0 points/10.7 rebounds) each averaged a double-double ... In three games against the Hawks, John Salmons tallied 30.7 points ... Milwaukee leads the all-time regular season series 96-92 (60-30 at home) ... The Hawks lead 61-34 in games played in Atlanta ... This is the fourth time the teams have met in the postseason (all in the first round) ... Milwaukee took a five game set (3-2) in 1983-84, the Hawks posted a 3-2 series win in 1987-88, and the Bucks won again in 1988-89 (3-2).

### NEWS & NOTES

\* Tickets for Round 1, Home Game 3 (Game 5 overall) against the Milwaukee Bucks at Philips Arena are on sale now. Game 5 is scheduled to be played on Wednesday, April 28 at either 7:30 or 8 p.m. Hawks fans may purchase Game 5 tickets by visiting [www.hawks.com](http://www.hawks.com), calling 1-800-4NBA-TIX, visiting the Philips Arena box office or at any Ticketmaster outlet. All major credit cards are accepted and customers may pay in cash at the Philips Arena box office. The box office is open Monday-Thursday from 9:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Friday from 9:30 a.m.-1 p.m. Fans interested in securing private or party suites for playoff games may do so by calling (866) 762-1900.

\* The April 28 playoff game against the Bucks also features the Chick-fil-A® Family Night promotion where fans can purchase four tickets and four Chick-fil-A® combo meal coupons starting at \$89. Visit [www.hawks.com](http://www.hawks.com) for more information.

\* In game 2 on 4/20, Josh Smith became the fourth player in NBA Playoff history to have at least 20 points, 8 rebounds and 8 assists in a game, while shooting 80% from the field. Smith finished the night with 21 points (9-11 FGs), 14 boards and 9 assists. The others to accomplish the feat are Mitch Richmond (Golden State, 5/2/89), Bill Russell (Boston, 4/19/65), and Magic Johnson (L.A. Lakers, 6/1/82).

\* Before dropping game 3, Atlanta held a 2-0 advantage in a seven-game series for the first time since 1970 (Western Division semifinals vs. Chicago). The last time the Hawks held a 2-0 lead in any playoff series was in round one against Detroit in 1999.

\* The Hawks are hosting two viewing parties presented by Budweiser (at Dugan's Tavern in Stone Mountain and the Hudson Grille in Midtown) for tonight's game 4 (8:30 p.m. ET tipoff). Festivities will include appearances by members of the A-Town Dancers and the Budweiser Promo Team, Hawks-themed contests, trivia, giveaways, and more.

\* Several Hawks have set or tied postseason career-highs in the Bucks series: Al Horford – 20 points and 8 FGM (4/20), 5 blocks (4/17), and 3 steals (4/24); Zaza Pachulia – 16 points and 6 FGM (4/24), and 2 blocks (4/17); Josh Smith – 14 rebounds and 9 assists (4/20); Marvin Williams – 8 rebounds (4/24).

\* Josh Smith finished second to childhood friend and fellow Atlanta-native Dwight Howard (Orlando Magic) for the 2009-10 NBA Defensive Player of the Year Award presented by Kia Motors. Smith tallied 136 total points (3 first place votes / 34 second place votes / 19 third place votes).
