#### ALL-TIME SERIES

The Hawks and Magic square-off in the postseason for the second time, after Orlando took a second round series in 1995-96, 4-1 ... The Magic lead the all-time regular season series 44-37, with Atlanta holding a 25-15 advantage in home games ... The Hawks have dropped three straight regular season games at Amway Arena and three-of-the last-four at Philips Arena ... The Magic have taken the regular season series the last two years (3-1 each year) ... Atlanta last posted a season series win in 2006-07, going 3-1 (2-0 at home, 1-1 on the road).

#### 2009-10 REGULAR SEASON SERIES

Orlando took the season series 3-1, including both games at Amway Arena (113-81 on 1/9 and 104-86 on 1/30) ... The teams split two games at Philips Arena, with Orlando winning the first game on Thanksgiving Day, 93-76 ... Atlanta won the final regular season meeting, 86-84 (3/24), on Josh Smith follow-up slam at the buzzer ... The Magic's 113-81 decision on 1/9 was the Hawks' worst loss of the season ... Joe Johnson was the Hawks' top scorer against the Magic this year at 16.3 ppg, while Smith (13.8) and Jamal Crawford (12.5) also averaged double-figures ... Smith also pulled down 8.3 rpg and Johnson handed out 5.0 apg ... Dwight Howard averaged 21.0 ppg and 16.8 rpg against the Hawks ... Atlanta finished second to Orlando in the Southeast Division (6 games back).

#### 2010 PLAYOFF SERIES RECAP

The Magic hold a 3-0 lead the best-of-seven Eastern Conference semifinals series with the Hawks ... Orlando has posted two home wins (114-71 on 5/4 and 112-98 on 5/6) and one victory at Philips Arena (105-75 on 5/8) ... Jamal Crawford is leading Atlanta in scoring during the series at 16.7 ppg ... Josh Smith (15.7), Al Horford (13.0) and Joe Johnson (12.3) are also averaging double-figures ... Atlanta-native Dwight Howard is leading the Magic at 23.7 ppg and 15.0 rpg in the series.

### NEWS & NOTES

\* On 5/6, Joe Johnson was named to the All-NBA Third Team. It is Johnson's first All-NBA Team honor of his career and he becomes the first Hawk since Dikembe Mutombo (Third Team in 1997-98) to land a spot on the All-NBA squad. He averaged 21.3 ppg (11<sup>th</sup> in the NBA), 4.9 apg (t26<sup>th</sup>), 4.6 rpg, 1.1 spg and 38.0 mpg (t10<sup>th</sup>), while shooting .458 FG%, .369 3FG% and .818 FT% in 76 regular season games (all starts). He also was 11<sup>th</sup> in the league in FGM (635) and t24<sup>th</sup> in 3FGM (129).

\* On 5/5, Josh Smith was named to the NBA All-Defensive Second Team. Smith is the first Hawk since 1998-99 (Dikembe Mutombo and Mookie Blaylock), and the eighth player in Atlanta history, to earn All-Defensive team honors. In 81 regular season games (all starts), he averaged 8.7 rpg (18<sup>th</sup> in the NBA), 2.1 bpg (3<sup>rd</sup>) and 1.6 spg (11<sup>th</sup>). At 6-foot-9, Smith was the tallest player in the top 12 in steals in the NBA, and the shortest in the top 12 in blocks. He also ranked 3<sup>rd</sup> in the league in total blocks (172).

\* Several Hawks rank among the NBA's best in a number of statistical categories this postseason: Al Horford is 7<sup>th</sup> in rpg (9.3), 7<sup>th</sup> in bpg (1.90) and 11<sup>th</sup> in FG% (.530) ... Josh Smith is 8<sup>th</sup> in rpg (9.1), 10<sup>th</sup> in bpg (1.80) and 23<sup>rd</sup> in FG% (.483) ... Joe Johnson is 11<sup>th</sup> in mpg (39.6), t14<sup>th</sup> in apg (5.0), 22<sup>nd</sup> in ppg (18.3) and 27<sup>th</sup> in FT% (.838) ... Marvin Williams is 10<sup>th</sup> in FT% (.906) ... Mike Bibby is t17<sup>th</sup> in 3FG% (.424) ... Jamal Crawford is 17<sup>th</sup> in FT% (.872).

\* Marvin Williams pulled down a postseason career-high 11 rebounds at Orlando on 5/6, and just missed his first ever playoff double-double, finishing with 9 points.

\* Al Horford is tied for 4<sup>th</sup> in the NBA during the postseason with 5 double-doubles, and Josh Smith is tied for 10<sup>th</sup> with 3.
