ALL-TIME SERIES

The Hawks and Magic square-off in the postseason for the second time, after Orlando took a second round series in 1995-96, 4-1 ... The Magic lead the all-time regular season series 44-37, with Atlanta holding a 25-15 advantage in home games ... The Hawks have dropped three straight regular season games at Amway Arena and three-of-the last-four at Philips Arena ... The Magic have take the regular season series the last two years (3-1 each year) ... Atlanta last posted a season series win in 2006-07, going 3-1 (2-0 at home, 1-1 on the road).

2009-10 REGULAR SEASON SERIES

Orlando took the season series 3-1, including both games at Amway Arena (113-81 on 1/9 and 104-86 on 1/30) ... The teams split two games at Philips Arena, with Orlando winning the first game on Thanksgiving Day, 93-76 ... Atlanta won the final regular season meeting, 86-84 (3/24), on Josh Smith follow-up slam at the buzzer ... The Magic's 113-81 decision on 1/9 was the Hawks' worst loss of the season ... Joe Johnson was the Hawks' top scorer against the Magic this year at 16.3 ppg, while Smith (13.8) and Jamal Crawford (12.5) also averaged double-figures ... Smith also pulled down 8.3 rpg and Johnson handed out 5.0 apg ... Dwight Howard averaged 21.0 ppg and 16.8 rpg against the Hawks ... Atlanta finished second to Orlando in the Southeast Division (6 games back).

HAWKS – MAGIC COMMON THREADS

Maurice Evans spent the 2007-08 with Orlando ... Zaza Pachulia was with the Magic for the 2003-04 season, and was originally drafted by Orlando in the second round (42nd overall) of the 2003 NBA Draft ... Dwight Howard played his high school ball at SW Atlanta Christian Academy, and was an AAU teammate of Josh Smith and Randolph Morris ... Anthony Johnson has had three stints playing for the Hawks, including 42 games in '07-'08.

NEWS & NOTES

* The NBA announced on 4/27 that Jamal Crawford, who came off the bench in all 79 games in which he appeared this season, is the winner of the 2009-10 NBA Sixth Man Award presented by Kia Motors as the league's best player in a reserve role. Crawford received 580 of a possible 610 points, including 110 of a possible 122 first-place votes, from a panel of 122 sportswriters and broadcasters throughout the United States and Canada. As part of its support of the Sixth Man Award, Kia Motors America will donate a 2011 Kia Sorento CUV on behalf of Crawford to Boys & Girls Clubs of Metro Atlanta. The 6'5 guard averaged 18.0 ppg, 3.0 apg and 2.5 rpg (.449 FG%, .382 3FG%, .857 FT%) during the regular season.

* Hawks postseason leaders include: Joe Johnson with 20.9 ppg and 5.7 apg, Al Horford with 9.9 rpg and .560 FG%, Josh Smith with 2.43 bpg, Marvin Williams at .917 FT% and Mike Bibby at .444 3FG%. Additionally, Johnson, Horford and Jamal Crawford are all tied for the team lead at 1.00 spg.

* Dating back to last year, the last seven Hawks playoff wins have come by double-digits.

* Atlanta held Milwaukee to 32.6% FG% shooting in Game 7 on 5/2 and 32.9% in Game 6 on 4/30. It is the second and third lowest shooting games by an opponent in franchise postseason history.

* Hawks playoff tickets for Round 2 (Games 3, 4 and 6) against the Orlando Magic at Philips Arena are on sale now. Game 3 is scheduled for Saturday, 5/8 at 5 p.m., while Game 4 is set for Monday, 5/10 at 8 p.m. Game 6 (if necessary) will be played on Friday, 5/14 (time TBD). Hawks fans may tickets by visiting www.hawks.com, calling 1-800-4NBA-TIX, visiting the Philips Arena box office or at any Ticketmaster outlet. All major credit cards are accepted and customers may pay in cash at the Philips Arena box office.
