### UPCOMING GAMES



**Tuesday, Nov. 2, 2010 at Cleveland Cavaliers (7 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM**

Atlanta travels to Cleveland for the first time in the first-of-three games with the Cavaliers ... Cleveland took last year's series 3-1, winning the first three games before Atlanta took a 99-83 home decision on 4/14 ... The Cavs currently own a six-game home winning streak against the Hawks ... The teams meet again on 12/22 at Philips Arena and 3/27 in Cleveland ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 103-93, but the Cavs hold a 59-41 advantage in home games.



**Wednesday, Nov. 3, 2010 vs. Detroit Pistons (7 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM**

The Hawks host Detroit in the first-of-four games between the clubs this year ... Atlanta visits the Motor City on 12/14 and 2/14, before hosting the Pistons on 3/20 to close out the season series ... The teams split last year's series at two games apiece, each winning twice at home ... Atlanta currently owns a three-game home winning streak against Detroit ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 161-157, but are 69-77 at home against the Pistons.



**Friday, Nov. 5, 2010 at Minnesota Timberwolves (8 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM**

Atlanta visits Minnesota for the only time this year in the first-of-two games with the Timberwolves ... Minnesota visits Philips Arena on 11/14 to finish the season series ... The Hawks swept last season's series 2-0, including a 112-87 road win on 12/22 ... Atlanta has won eight-in-a-row against the T'Wolves, including four straight in Minnesota ... The Timberwolves last win was an 84-83 home triumph on 4/9/06 ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 25-15 (10-10 on the road).



**Sunday, Nov. 7, 2010 vs. Phoenix Suns (5 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM**

The Hawks host Phoenix for the only time this year in the first-of-two games with the Suns ... Atlanta visits Phoenix on 2/23 to close-out the season series ... The clubs split last year's series 1-1, each winning at home ... The Hawks have take two-of-the-last-three at Philips Arena ... The Suns lead the all-time series 63-47, with the Hawks holding a 29-23 advantage in home games.

### NEWS & NOTES

\* The Hawks have won their first three games of the season (for the second time in the last three years), including two on the road. The two-game road winning streak equals their high from last season, and Atlanta has now won four straight on the road dating back to last year. The 1988-89 campaign was the last time (and only other time in Atlanta history) the Hawks opened with two road wins in their first two games.

\* Joe Johnson needs four assists to move past Lou Hudson (2098) for 10th place on the Hawks all-time list.

\* Savannah College of Art and Design sequential art professor Shawn Crystal has collaborated with ESPN The Magazine and Marvel Comics for their NBA preview issue that hit newsstands 10/22. \* Through the first week of the 2010-11 season, Josh Smith is leading the NBA in blocked shots (4.33) and Zaza Pachulia is tied for the league led in FT% (12-12 FTs, 1.000%). As a team, the Hawks are tops in the NBA in FT% at 85.9%.

\* Pape Sy has been inactive all three regular season games with a lower back injury, while Maurice Evans has missed the last two contests due to his right knee.
