### UPCOMING GAMES



**Tuesday, Nov. 16, 2010 at Indiana Pacers (7 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM**

The Hawks and Pacers meet in the first-of-four games and for the first-of-two in Indiana ... The Pacers come to Philips Arena on 12/11 and 1/8, and host Atlanta again on 4/8 to finish the season series ... The Hawks swept last year's series 3-0, including the only contest at Conseco Fieldhouse (110-98 on 12/26/09) ... Atlanta has won six consecutive games overall against the Pacers, including two straight on the road ... Indiana's last win was a 113-96 home triumph on 11/18/08 ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 85-73, with the Pacers holding a 48-31 edge in home games.



**Saturday, Nov. 20, 2010 vs. Dallas Mavericks (8 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD/NBA TV... Radio: 97.9 FM**

Atlanta hosts the Mavericks for the only time this year in the first-of-two games between the clubs ... The Hawks visit Dallas on 1/29 to close-out the season series ... The teams split last year's series at one game apiece, each winning on the road ... Atlanta earned an 80-75 win on 12/5 before falling 111-103 in overtime on 2/26 ... The Hawks' last home win against the Mavs came on 3/19/09 (95-87) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 31-28, including a 17-12 home mark.
