### UPCOMING GAMES

**Monday, Nov. 22, 2010 vs. Boston Celtics (7 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM**

Atlanta and Boston meet in the first-of-three games this year and the first-of-two at Philips Arena ... The Celtics host the Hawks on 12/16 and visit Philips Arena again 4/1 to finish the season series ... Atlanta swept last year's series, 4-0, for the first time since 1998-99 (3-0) ... Boston leads the all-time series 214-130, with the Hawks holding an 82-78 advantage in home games.

**Tuesday, Nov. 23, 2010 at New Jersey Nets (7 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM**

The Nets host Atlanta for the first time this year in the first-of-four games between the clubs ... The Hawks return to New Jersey on 12/19 and host the Nets on 12/7 and 3/26 to close-out the season series ... Atlanta swept last year's series, 3-0, including the only contest in New Jersey (108-84 on 3/16) ... The Hawks currently have four-game winning streak against the Nets overall ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 82-63 (30-43 on the road).

**Thursday, Nov. 25, 2010 vs. Washington Wizards (8 p.m.)**

**TV: TNT ... Radio: 97.9 FM**

The Hawks host the Wizards for the second-and-final time this year in the second-of-four games between the teams ... Atlanta travels to the nation's capital on 2/5 and 4/9 to finish the season series ... The Hawks took game one 99-95 at Philips Arena on 10/30 ... Joe Johnson led the way with 25 points, while Al Horford (21 points/10 rebounds) and Josh Smith (12 points/10 rebounds) posted double-doubles ... John Wall paced Washington with 28 points ... Atlanta has won 10 straight against the Wizards, including five-in-a-row at Philips Arena ... Washington's last win in the series was 102-98 overtime decision at Philips Arena on 1/11/08 ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 136-132, including an 85-42 home record.

**Saturday, Nov. 27, 2010 at New York Knicks (1 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM**

Atlanta visits the Big Apple for the first time this season in the first-of-four games against the Knicks ... The teams play again on 1/28 (Philips Arena), 2/16 (Madison Square Garden) and 3/6 (Philips Arena) ... New York took last season's series, 3-1, winning the final three contests, including the last game at Madison Square Garden ... Atlanta won the first game last year, 114-101, on 11/11 in New York ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 181-161, with the Knicks holding an 84-58 edge in home games.

**Sunday, Nov. 28, 2010 at Toronto Raptors (1 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM**

The Hawks go north of the border for first time this year in the first-of-three games against Toronto ... Atlanta visits Toronto again on 1/12 before hosting the Raptors at Philips Arena on 2/2 to finish the season series ... The Hawks took last season's series, 3-1, splitting two games in Toronto (a 111-89 win on 12/11 and a 106-105 loss on 3/17) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 31-26, including a 14-14 record in road games.

\* Recently, as part of the NBA Players Association's (NBPA) 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Great Turkey Giveaway, the NBPA provided more than 230 USDA Grade A turkeys to Atlanta Hawk Josh Smith's partner non-profit, the Hosea Feed the Hungry & Homeless, in an effort to make the Thanksgiving holiday a happy one for families in need. In addition, the NBPA distributed 1000 more turkeys to families in the Atlanta area.

### NEWS & NOTES

\* Mike Bibby, Jamal Crawford, Al Horford, Joe Johnson, Josh Smith and Marvin Williams are all featured on the 2011 NBA All-Star Ballot, unveiled on 11/18. The 60<sup>th</sup> All-Star Game, which will broadcast live on TNT and ESPN Radio in the US, and reach fans in more than 200 countries and territories in more than 40 languages, will be played at STAPLES Center in Los Angeles on Sunday, Feb. 20, 2011.

\* The Hawks' frontcourt tandem of Al Horford (7) and Josh Smith (5) both rank among the NBA leaders in double-doubles. Horford ranks tied for fifth in the league, while Smith is tied for 17<sup>th</sup>.

\* Al Horford recorded his second career 20/20 on 11/20 vs. Dallas, finishing with 20 points and 20 rebounds, while also tying season-highs of 5 assists and 3 blocks.

\* Josh Smith is averaging 22.3 ppg on .561 FG% over the last four games, topping 20 points in each contest. He has now scored 20-or-more six times this year.

\* The Hawks are off to a 5-1 road start, their best beginning away from home since starting the 1997-98 campaign with an identical mark. Last season, Atlanta was 4-2 through six road games, and went 19-22 on the year.

\* Josh Smith swiped a season-high 5 steals on 11/20 vs. Dallas, in the process moving past Jason Terry for the 6<sup>th</sup> on the Hawks' all-time steals list (now at 590).

\* Jamal Crawford has added two four-point plays this season (11/5 at Minnesota and 11/7 vs. Phoenix) to his all-time NBA record and now has 30 for his career. Prior to his arrival, the Hawks had compiled just nine in team history. He now has 11 as a Hawk.
