UPCOMING GAMES



Monday, Nov. 8, 2010 at Orlando Magic (7 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM

Atlanta visits Orlando for the first time this year in the first-of-four games with the Magic ... The teams play again on 12/6 in Orlando, and twice at Philips Arena (12/20 and 3/30) to close-out the season series ... The Magic took last season's series 3-1 but the Hawks won the last meeting 86-84 at Philips Arena ... Orlando also swept the Hawks 4-0 in the Eastern Conference Semifinals ... Atlanta has dropped three straight road regular season road games to the Magic ... Orlando leads the all-time series 44-37, including a 29-12 home record.



Wednesday, Nov. 10, 2010 vs. Milwaukee Bucks (7 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM

The Bucks come to Philips Arena for the first time in the first-of-four games with Atlanta ... The clubs meet again in Milwaukee on 12/27 and 1/26, and at Philips Arena on 1/11 ... The Hawks won two-of-three versus Milwaukee last year, including the only contest in Atlanta ... Atlanta is looking for their second straight win overall against the Bucks and seventh consecutive home triumph ... The teams also met in the first round of the 2010 NBA Playoffs, with the Hawks coming out on top 4-3 ... Milwaukee leads the all-time series 96-92, with the Hawks holding a 61-34 advantage in home games.



Friday, Nov. 12, 2010 vs. Utah Jazz (7 p.m.)

TV: ESPN ... Radio: 97.9 FM

The Hawks host the Jazz for the only time this year in the first-of-two games between the clubs ... Atlanta visits Utah on 1/5 to finish the season series ... The Hawks swept the Jazz last year, 2-0, for the first time since 1992-93, including a 96-83 home victory ... Atlanta has a three-game winning streak against Utah overall and has also won three straight at Philips Arena ... The Jazz lead the all-time series 47-39, with the Hawks leading 27-16 in home games.



Sunday, Nov. 14, 2010 vs. Minnesota Timberwolves (2 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM

Atlanta hosts Minnesota for the only time this year in the second-of-two meetings between the clubs ... The Hawks took a 113-103 road decision on 11/5 behind 22 points from Jamal Crawford and Al Horford's double-double (14 points/12 boards) ... Atlanta has now nine straight overall against the Timberwolves and seven-in-a-row at Philips Arena ... The Timberwolves' last win in the series was an 84-83 home triumph on 4/9/06 and their last win at Philips Arena came on 11/20/02 (103-93) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 26-15, including a 15-5 home mark.

* Hawks players and coaches will hold a Thanksgiving event on 11/17 at City of Refuge in Atlanta. More details about this event will be released in the near future.

* Hall-of-Famer and Hawks VP of Basketball Dominique Wilkins joined Bob Williams, Atlanta Hawks and Philips Arena, and EVP, Atlanta Spirit LLC in presenting \$25,000 in grants from the Atlanta Hawks Foundation to five area non-profit organizations at halftime of the Hawks vs. Suns game at Philips Arena on 11/7. Representatives from American Association of Adapted Sports Program, CHOICES, Future Foundation, Girls on the Run, and Ryan Cameron Foundation also participated in the ceremony.

NEWS & NOTES

* On 11/1 the Atlanta Hawks announced that the team has agreed to terms on a multi-year extension with center Al Horford. Per team policy, terms of the contract were not disclosed.

* The Hawks started the season 6-0 (before dropping a 118-114 decision to Phoenix on 11/7), giving Larry Drew the best start by a first-year head coach in Atlanta history.

* Against Phoenix on 11/7, Josh Smith passed Dikembe Mutombo for 2nd place on the Hawks all-time blocks list (now at 1095), and tied Kevin Willis for 7th all-time in steals at 581.

* On 11/2 at Cleveland, Joe Johnson moved into 10th place, passing Lou Hudson, on the Hawks' all-time assists chart (now at 2123). Johnson also pulled down his 3000th career rebound versus Phoenix on 11/7.

* Jamal Crawford extended his own NBA record with his 30th career 4-point play versus the Suns on 11/7.

* On 11/2 the Atlanta Hawks announced a new multi-year partnership with Skyview Networks to serve as Official Radio Network Provider. Skyview, an integrated professional sports broadcast company specializing in play-by-play broadcast systems, will provide satellite distribution for radio, wise satellite receivers and Live Read Management Service to the Atlanta Hawks Radio Network.

* The Hawks-Bucks game on 11/10 features the Aaron's Lucky Dog Wednesday promotion where fans purchase upper level tickets for \$17 ...
