UPCOMING GAMES



Monday, Dec. 6, 2010 at Orlando Magic (7 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM

Atlanta visits Orlando for the second-and-final time this year in the second-of-four games between the clubs ... The Magic took a 93-89 decision in game one (11/8) behind 27 points and 11 boards from Dwight Howard ... Joe Johnson's 23 points paced the Hawks and Josh Smith posted a double-double (13 points/13 rebounds) ... The Magic come to Philips Arena on 12/20 and 3/30 to finish the season series ... The Hawks have dropped four straight games in Orlando ... The Magic lead the all-time series 45-37, including a 30-12 home record.



Tuesday, Dec. 7, 2010 vs. New Jersey Nets (7 p.m.)

The Hawks host the Nets for the first time this year in the second-of-four games between the teams ... New Jersey took the first meeting (at home), 107-101 in overtime, on 11/23, snapping Atlanta's four-game win streak in the series ... Jamal Crawford's 21 points led the Hawks and Al Horford recorded a double-double (14 points/10 rebounds) ... Brooke Lopez scored 32 and Devin Harris 27 for the Nets ... The clubs play again on 12/19 (at New Jersey) and at Philips Arena on 3/26 to close out the season series ... Atlanta has won three straight at Philips Arena against New Jersey ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 82-64, including a 52-20 home mark.



Friday, Dec. 10, 2010 at San Antonio Spurs (8:30 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM

Atlanta heads to San Antonio for the only time this year in the first-of-two meetings with the Spurs ... San Antonio comes to Philips Arena on 4/5 to finish the season series ... The teams split two games last year, each winning at home ... The Hawks took the last match-up, 119-114 in overtime, on 3/21/10 ... Atlanta has dropped 12 straight in San Antonio, with their last win coming on 2/15/97 (109-89) ... The Spurs lead the all-time series 40-36 (26-12 at home).



Saturday, Dec. 11, 2010 vs. Indiana Pacers (7 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM

The Hawks and Pacers tangle for the second time this year and for the first time at Philips Arena ... Atlanta posted a 102-92 road triumph in the first meeting on 11/16, behind Josh Smith's 25 points ... Danny Granger had 22 points for Indiana and Roy Hibbert tallied 18 points and 15 boards ... The Hawks have seven-in-a-row against the Pacers and six straight at Philips Arena ... The Pacers last won in Atlanta on 12/22/06 (100-90) ... The teams play again on 1/8 in Atlanta and 4/8 in Indiana ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 86-73, including a 53-25 home mark.

NEWS & NOTES

- * The Hawks signed free agent swingman Damien Wilkins on 12/3. The son of former NBA player Gerald Wilkins and nephew of Hawks Hall-of-Famer Dominique Wilkins, he has appeared in 390 regular season NBA games over six seasons with Seattle/Oklahoma City (2004-09) and Minnesota (2009-10), and owns career averages of 7.2 ppg, 2.7 rpg and 1.6 apg (.421 FG%, .333 3FG%, .807 FT%).
- * Joe Johnson had right elbow surgery on 12/2 and is expected to miss four-to-six weeks of action.
- * The Hawks won their final three games of November, clinching a winning month for the 12th consecutive time (began in February 2009), which matches the longest streak in Atlanta history (January 1996 through November 1997).
- * Marvin Williams tied a career-high with 4 steals vs. Philadelphia on 12/3, while Jeff Teague matched his career-best with 5 rebounds in the same game.
- * Al Horford had the best shooting performance by a Hawks player this year at Miami on 12/4, hitting 10-11 FGs (.909 FG%) on his way to 22 points. The Hawks center currently ranks 3rd in the NBA at .598 FG% on the season.
- * Mike Bibby is leading the NBA in 3FG% at .529 and ranks tied for 4th in 3FGM with 45.
