### UPCOMING GAMES



**Monday, Jan. 17, 2011 vs. Sacramento Kings (4 p.m.)**  
**TV: SportSouth HD/NBA TV ... Radio: 97.9 FM**

Atlanta hosts Sacramento for the only time this year in the second-of-two meetings between the teams ... The Hawks took a 108-102 road decision in game one, behind Jamal Crawford's 31 points and 29 from Joe Johnson ... Tyreke Evans paced the Kings with 29 points ... Atlanta currently owns a six-game winning streak in the series, including four straight at Philips Arena ... Sacramento's last win against the Hawks was a 119-107 home triumph on 2/20/08 and their last victory in Atlanta came on 3/3/06 (102-93) ... The Kings lead the all-time series 152-148, but the Hawks hold an 82-29 advantage in home games.



**Tuesday, Jan. 18, 2011 at Miami Heat (7:30 p.m.)**  
**TV: SportSouth HD/NBA TV ... Radio: 97.9 FM**

The Hawks head to Miami for the second time this year in the second-of-four contests with the Heat ... The teams play again on 3/18 and 4/11 at Philips Arena to close out the season series ... Miami took game one, 89-77, on 12/4 as Chris Bosh, LeBron James and Dwyane Wade all topped 20 points ... Al Horford's 22 points led Atlanta ... The Heat currently have a four-game win streak against the Hawks and have also won four straight at home ... The Hawks' last win in the series was a 105-90 home decision on 11/18/09 ... Miami leads the all-time series 46-38, including a 32-11 home mark.



**Friday, Jan. 21, 2011 vs. New Orleans Hornets (7:30 p.m.)**  
**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM**

The Hawks host the Hornets for the only time this year in the second-of-two meetings between the clubs ... New Orleans posted a 93-86 triumph in game one on 12/26 behind Chris Paul's 22 points ... Joe Johnson led all scorers with 23 that night ... The Hornets have won two straight over Atlanta, but the Hawks have taken the last two at Philips Arena ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 41-37 (25-15 at home).



**Saturday, Jan. 22, 2011 at Charlotte Bobcats (7 p.m.)**  
**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM**

Atlanta heads to Charlotte for the first time this year in the second-of-four games against the Bobcats ... All five starters scored in double-figures during the Hawks' 90-85 win in game one (12/17) ... D.J. Augustin and Boris Diaw each had 22 points for the Bobcats ... Atlanta has lost three-in-a-row in Charlotte with their last road win coming on 2/6/09 (102-97) ... The Bobcats leads the all-time series 14-11, including a 10-2 home record.

### NEWS & NOTES

\* The Hawks-Bucks game originally scheduled for 1/11/11 at Philips Arena was postponed until 3/15/11 (7 p.m. tipoff) due to severe weather in Atlanta.

\* Joe Johnson has been climbing the all-time Hawks leader boards this season and has recently moved into eighth in scoring (8748) and field goals made (3284), and seventh in assists (2249).

\* Al Horford ranks as one of the top all-around rebounders in the NBA. The Hawks center is currently 8<sup>th</sup> in rpg (9.7), 7<sup>th</sup> in def. rpg (7.2) and 18<sup>th</sup> in off. rpg (2.5).

\* Jamal Crawford scored 36 points at Toronto on 1/12, hitting 12-23 FGs, 4-11 3FGs and 8-8 FTs. It was most points scored off the bench in the NBA this season.

\* Marvin Williams has missed the last seven games with a back contusion. His status is currently listed as day-to-day.

\* Rookie Pape Sy, currently on an NBA D-League assignment, is averaging for 5.7 ppg, 3.7 rpg and 1.9 apg (.250 FG%, .760 FT%) in seven games (one start) for the Utah Flash.

\* Al Horford is the only player in the NBA hitting 55%-or-better from the field, and 82%-or-better from the free throw line this season. The last player to reach those marks for a full season was Chris Mullin (Golden State) in 1996-97 (.553 FG%/.864 FT%).
