UPCOMING GAMES



Wednesday, Jan. 26, 2011 at Milwaukee Bucks (8 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM

Atlanta travels to Milwaukee for the second time in the third-of-four games with the Bucks ... The teams have split two games so far, each winning on the road ... The Bucks took game one, 108-91 on 11/10, behind Corey Maggette's 20 points ... Zaza Pachulia scored 16 for the Hawks ... Atlanta evened things up with a 95-80 triumph on 12/27, thanks to Al Horford's 18 points and 12 rebounds ... The clubs were also originally set to play on 1/11 at Philips Arena but the game was re-scheduled for 3/15 due to weather conditions in Atlanta ... The Hawks have won two straight road games in the series ... Milwaukee leads the all-time series 97-93 (60-31 in home games).



Friday, Jan. 28, 2011 vs. New York Knicks (7:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM

New York comes to Philips Arena for the first time this year in the second-of-four games against the Hawks ... Atlanta posted a 99-90 victory at Madison Square Garden on 11/27 in the first meeting ... Six Hawks scored in double-figures led by Jamal Crawford's 21 ... The Knicks' Amar'e Stoudemire put in 24 to lead all scorers ... The teams play again on 2/16 in New York and 3/6 at Philips Arena to finish the season series ... The Knicks won the last game at Philips Arena, 112-108 in overtime, on 1/1/10 ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 182-161, including a 99-46 home record.



Saturday, Jan. 29, 2011 at Dallas Mavericks (8:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD/NBA TV ... Radio: 97.9 FM

The Hawks visit Dallas for the only time this year in the second-of-two meetings with the Mavericks ... Dallas took game one at Philips Arena (98-93) on 11/20 ... Dirk Nowitzki scored 21 to lead the Mavericks ... Josh Smith had 21 points for Atlanta and Al Horford tallied 20 points and 20 rebounds ... The Mavs have taken two straight in the series, but Atlanta won the last contest in Dallas, 80-75, on 12/5/09 ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 31-29, with Dallas holding a 16-14 advantage in home games.

* Hawks forward and Riverdale native Josh Powell will dedicate a new computer lab at his alma mater, Riverdale High School, on 1/24. The event is slated to begin at 2:30 p.m. Powell recently purchased new computers for the school in addition to paying for the lab to be refurbished.

* Guard Mike Bibby and Hall-of-Famer Dominique Wilkins, along with Strength & Conditioning Coach Chatten Hill, will lead an NBA FIT and Basketball Skills Clinic for over 60 kids from C.H.O.I.C.E.S. (The Center Helping Obesity in Children End Successfully Inc.) on 1/24. The event will begin at 5 p.m. on the Hawks practice court at Philips Arena.

NEWS & NOTES

* The Hawks are currently on a season best six-game road winning streak. It is the first time since 1993-94 that Atlanta has won six straight road games. With a 15-9 road mark, the Hawks are tied for the most road wins in the NBA (with Miami and the Lakers).

* Joe Johnson went over the 13,000 career point mark at Charlotte on 1/22, while also making his 5000th career field goal. Additionally, Josh Smith and Maurice Evans each played in their 500th career game at Miami on 1/18.

* Al Horford recorded a career-high 7 blocked shots on 1/17 versus Sacramento, while also posting 23 points, 9 rebounds and 6 assists.

* With the 1/18 win at Miami, the Hawks clinched a winning month for the 14th consecutive time (began in February 2009), which is the longest streak in Atlanta history, surpassing the 12 straight from January 1996 through November 1997.

* Al Horford (sprained right ankle) and Marvin Williams (back contusion) are listed as day-to-day.

* On 1/18, Atlanta signed Damien Wilkins to a second 10-day contract. The seventh-year veteran signed his first 10-day contract on 1/8. He was originally signed by the Hawks on 12/3, and waived on 1/5.

THIS WEEK IN HAWKS HISTORY

January 24, 1960 – The St. Louis Hawks post a 155-129 home victory over the New York Knicks, setting single-game franchise records for points and assists (47). The Hawks also scored 155 points in a game at San Diego on February 11, 1970.
