### UPCOMING GAMES



**Tuesday, Jan. 4, 2011 at Sacramento Kings (10 p.m.)**  
**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM**

Atlanta visits Sacramento for the only time this year in the first-of-two contests between the teams ... The Kings come to Philips Arena on 1/17 to finish the season series ... The Hawks swept last season's series 2-0, including a 113-105 road win on 11/4/09 ... Atlanta currently has a five-game winning streak against the Kings, including two straight in Sacramento ... Sacramento's last victory over Atlanta was a 119-107 home decision on 2/20/08 ... The Kings lead the all-time series 152-147, including a 71-40 home record.



**Wednesday, Jan. 5, 2011 at Utah Jazz (9 p.m.)**  
**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM**

The Hawks head to Utah for the only time this year in second-and-final game against the Jazz ... Utah took game one, 90-86, at Philips Arena on 11/12 ... Deron Williams led the way with 24 points and 11 assists, while Al Jefferson (15 points/10 rebounds) and Andrei Kirilenko (14 points/12 boards) also had double-doubles ... Joe Johnson paced Atlanta with 23 points and Josh Smith added 20 points and 13 rebounds ... The loss snapped a three-game Hawks winning streak in the series ... Atlanta took the last meeting in Utah, 105-100, on 2/22/10 ... The Jazz lead the all-time series 47-39 (31-11 at home).



**Saturday, Jan. 8, 2011 vs. Indiana Pacers (7 p.m.)**  
**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM**

Indiana comes to Philips Arena for the second-and-final time in the third-of-four contests with the Hawks ... Atlanta is 2-0 against the Pacers this year, posting a 102-92 road triumph on 11/16 and a 97-83 home decision on 12/11 ... Josh Smith led all scorers with 25 points in game one, while Danny Granger led the home team with 22 ... In game two, Jamal Crawford had 25 points for the Hawks and Mike Dunleavy scored 16 to lead the Pacers ... Atlanta currently has an eight-game winning streak against Indiana, including seven-in-a-row at Philips Arena ... The Pacers' last win over the Hawks came on 11/18/08 (113-96 in Indiana) and their last win in Atlanta was on 12/22/06 (100-90) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 87-73, including a 54-25 home mark.

### NEWS & NOTES

\* Joe Johnson moved into 10<sup>th</sup> place, passing Lenny Wilkens, on the Hawks' all-time scoring list on 12/29 versus Golden State (currently at 8641 points). Johnson also jumped into 8<sup>th</sup> place all-time in assists (ahead of Jason Terry) at Oklahoma City on 12/31 (currently at 2237 assists).

\* On 12/27, the Hawks assigned rookie Pape Sy to the Utah Flash of the NBA Development League. Sy was the Hawks' second round pick (53<sup>rd</sup> overall selection) in the 2010 NBA Draft.

\* After a 3-5 start this season at Philips Arena, the Hawks have won their last nine home contests to improve to 12-5. Since the start of the 2008-09 season, Atlanta has recorded a 77-22 (.778) mark on their home court.

\* Joe Johnson set a new career-high by making 14 free throws (14-17) against the Los Angeles Clippers on 1/2, finishing the game with 29 points in a 107-98 Hawks win.

\* Marvin Williams is currently out of action with a lower back contusion.
