UPCOMING GAMES



Wednesday, Feb. 2, 2011 vs. Toronto Raptors (7 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM

Toronto visits Philips Arena for the only time this year in the third-and-final contest against the Hawks ... Atlanta has posted two road victories over the Raptors this season – 96-78 on 11/28 and 104-101 on 1/12 ... Josh Smith posted a triple-double in game one (12 points, 13 rebounds and 10 assists) ... In game two, Jamal Crawford led the way with a season-high 36 points, the most by bench player in the NBA this season ... Atlanta has won three straight against Toronto overall and has taken five-in-a-row at Philips Arena ... The Raptors last win in Atlanta came on 12/11/07 (100-88) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 33-26, including a 17-12 home mark.



Friday, Feb. 4, 2011 vs. Los Angeles Clippers (7:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM

The Clippers come to Atlanta for the only time this season in the second-and-final meeting between the clubs ... The Hawks took game one, 107-98, on 1/2 ... Three players scored over 20 points for Atlanta – Joe Johnson (29), Jamal Crawford (24) and Josh Smith (22 and 10 rebounds) ... Blake Griffin led Los Angeles with 31 points and 15 boards ... The Hawks own a three-game winning streak against L.A., including the last game at Philips Arena (103-97 on 2/3/10) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 69-36 (39-13 at home).



Saturday, Feb. 5, 2011 at Washington Wizards (7 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD/NBA TV ... Radio: 97.9 FM

Atlanta visits the nation's capital for the first time this year in the third-of-four games with the Wizards ... The Hawks own two home victories over Washington this season – 99-95 on 10/30 and 116-96 on Thanksgiving (11/25) ... Joe Johnson led the way in game one with 25 points, while Al Horford (21 points/10 rebounds) and Josh Smith (12 points/10 boards) posted double-doubles ... Game two was the same story with Johnson scoring 21, while Smith (20 points/14 rebounds) and Horford (15 points/13 boards) recorded double-doubles ... Atlanta has an 11-game winning streak against the Wizards, including six straight in Washington DC ... The Wizards last win in the series was a 102-98 (OT) decision on 1/11/08 and their last home win came on 3/2/07 (93-92) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 137-13 (43-85 on the road).

COMMUNITY NEWS

* As part of this year's celebration of Black History Month, the Atlanta Hawks are honoring prominent African-American leaders during home games in February for their civic contributions, accomplishments and leadership. Beginning with the Hawks – Raptors game on 2/2, the team will recognize individuals from the Atlanta area who have excelled in these areas during special in-game ceremonies. Honorees include Red Moore, Alexis Scott, Kenny Leon and the Hosea Feed the Hungry & Homeless organization.

NEWS & NOTES

* On 1/28, Atlanta signed swingman Damien Wilkins for the remainder of the season. The seventh-year veteran was originally signed by the Hawks on 12/3, and waived on 1/5, before signing consecutive 10-day contracts on 1/8 and 1/18.

* For the month of January, Joe Johnson averaged 26.0 ppg on .504 FG%, .354 3FG% and .823 FT%, all monthly highs for the season. He also averaged over 10 made field goals per game. He topped 20 points 10 times during the month (seven straight from 1/2-1/17), including four 30-point efforts.

* Last year's Sixth Man Award winner Jamal Crawford is having an equally strong impact this season, leading the NBA in bench scoring at 15.9 ppg. His 36 points at Toronto (1/12) is highest total by a bench player in the NBA this season.

* Josh Smith went over 1500 career assists at Dallas on 1/29.

* Mike Bibby has not committed a turnover in his last six games (180 minutes of playing time). He ranks 10th in the NBA this season in A/TO ratio at 2.98.

* At Dallas on 1/29 Jamal Crawford extended his own NBA record with his 32nd career four-point play (his fourth of the season).

* The Hawks will host "Clark Howard Night" on 2/44 when the team takes on the Los Angeles Clippers at Philips Arena (7:30 p.m. tipoff). A number of discounts on tickets, concessions and merchandise are being offered to coincide with Howard's appearance, including: Select tickets for \$7.50; \$7.50 concessions combos on the upper concourse level, Stir Crazy and Veni Vidi Vici; \$7.50 selected merchandise. February 5, 1972 – Pete Maravich scores 50 points in Atlanta's 120-117 home win over Cleveland. It is tied for the ninth-highest single game scoring effort in franchise history. Maravich's 20 made field goals (20-27) are tied for sixth on the club's all-time list.
