### UPCOMING GAMES



**Monday, Feb. 14, 2011 at Detroit Pistons (7:30 p.m.)**  
**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM**

Atlanta visits The Motor City for the second-and-final time this year in the third-of-four contests with the Pistons ... The teams have split two games so far, each winning at home ... The Hawks posted a 94-85 decision on 11/3 before Detroit evened things up with a 103-80 triumph on 12/14 ... Josh Smith led the way for Atlanta in game one with 22 points and 11 rebounds, with Ben Gordon scoring 22 for the Pistons ... Smith had 26 points in game two and Al Horford recorded a double-double (17 points/12 rebounds) ... Richard Hamilton tallied 24 points for Detroit, while Charlie Villanueva (23 points/11 boards) and Rodney Stuckey (16 points/10 assists) had double-doubles ... The Pistons come to Philips Arena on 3/20 to finish the season series ... Atlanta has dropped three straight road games to Detroit, with their last win coming on 2/11/09 (99-95) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 162-158, including a 78-70 road mark.



**Wednesday, Feb. 16, 2011 at New York Knicks (7:30 p.m.)**

The Hawks head to The Big Apple for the second-and-final time this year in the third-of-four meetings with the Knicks ... Atlanta has taken the first two games, winning 99-90 on the road (11/27) and 111-102 at home (1/28) ... Six Hawks scored in double-figures in game one, led by Jamal Crawford's 21 ... Amar'e Stoudemire had 24 points and 10 rebounds for New York ... Atlanta's Joe Johnson led all scorers in game two with 34 points and Al Horford recorded a double-double (19 points/14 boards) ... Stoudemire scored 27 for the Knicks and Raymond Felton posted 21 points and 13 assists ... New York returns to Philips Arena on 3/6 to close-out the season series ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 183-161, with New York holding a 84-59 advantage in home games.

\* As part of this year's celebration of Black History Month, the Atlanta Hawks honored prominent African-American leaders during home games in February for their civic contributions, accomplishments and leadership. The team recognized individuals from the Atlanta area who have excelled in these areas during special in-game ceremonies. Honorees included Red Moore, Alexis Scott, Kenny Leon and the Hosea Feed the Hungry & Homeless organization.

### NEWS & NOTES

\* For the second straight season, the Atlanta Hawks will have two players on the All-Star team, as the NBA announced on 2/3 that guard Joe Johnson and center Al Horford have been named as reserves to the 2011 NBA Eastern Conference All-Star squad. The game takes place on 2/20 at the STAPLES Center in Los Angeles, CA, with coverage on TNT and ESPN Radio beginning at 7 p.m.

\* Hawks center Al Horford will team-up with former Hawks star Steve Smith and the Atlanta Dream's Coco Miller in the Haier Shooting Stars competition during NBA All-Star Weekend in Los Angeles. The trio will compete against teams from Texas, Chicago and Los Angeles. The event will be televised live on TNT as part of the NBA All-Star Saturday Night (2/19) presented by State Farm.

\* With 5 assists against Charlotte on 2/12, Joe Johnson moved into a tie for sixth with Hall-of-Famer Dominique Wilkins on the Hawks' all-time assist chart at 2321. Another Hall of Fame member, Bob Pettit is fifth all-time with 2369 assists.

\* Marvin Williams has made 22 consecutive free throws and has moved up to 39<sup>th</sup> in the NBA in FT% (.832).

\* Center Jason Collins went over the 2500 career point mark versus Charlotte on 2/12.

Wilkins set team records for points in a quarter (28) and half (36) during the game, and his 20 made field goals is tied for sixth on the team's all-time list.
