UPCOMING GAMES



Tuesday, Feb. 8, 2011 vs. Philadelphia 76ers (7 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM

Philadelphia comes to Philips Arena for the second-and-final time in the third-of-four contests with the Hawks this year ... Atlanta has taken the first two games – winning 104-101 going away on 10/29 and 93-88 at home on 12/3 ... Joe Johnson led the way in game one with 22 points and Al Horford tallied 20 points and 12 rebounds ... Andre Iguodala had 27 points and 10 assists for the 76ers ... Marvin Williams led all scorers in game two with 22 points and Horford recorded another double-double (15 points/13 boards) ... Elton Brand paced the Sixers with 16 points and 14 rebounds ... Atlanta has won two straight home games against Philly, with the 76ers last win at Philips Arena coming on 1/11/09 (109-94) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 157-152 (96-49 at home).



Saturday, Feb. 12, 2011 vs. Charlotte Hornets (7 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD/NBA TV ... Radio: 97.9 FM

The Hawks host the Bobcats for the second-and-final time this year in the third-of-four games between the clubs ... Atlanta is 2-0 so far against Charlotte, posting a 90-85 home win on 12/17 and a 103-87 road triumph on 1/22 ... All five Hawks starters scored in double-figures in game one, with Joe Johnson, Al Horford and Marvin Williams each putting in 16 points ... Josh Smith added a double-double (12 points/11 rebounds) ... D.J. Augustin and former Hawk Boris Diaw scored 22 apiece to lead Charlotte ... Johnson exploded for 32 points to lead all scorers in game two, while Augustin's 20 paced the Bobcats ... Atlanta has won seven-straight games at Philips Arena against Charlotte, with the Bobcats' last win coming on 1/19/07 ... Charlotte leads the all-time series 14-12 but the Hawks hold a 9-4 advantage in home games.

COMMUNITY NEWS

* As part of this year's celebration of Black History Month, the Atlanta Hawks are honoring prominent African-American leaders during home games in February for their civic contributions, accomplishments and leadership. Beginning with the Hawks – Raptors game on 2/2, the team will recognize individuals from the Atlanta area who have excelled in these areas during special in-game ceremonies. Honorees include Red Moore, Alexis Scott, Kenny Leon and the Hosea Feed the Hungry & Homeless organization.

NEWS & NOTES

* For the second straight season, the Atlanta Hawks will have two players on the All-Star team, as the NBA announced on 2/3 that guard Joe Johnson and center Al Horford have been named as reserves to the 2011 NBA Eastern Conference All-Star squad. The game takes place on 2/20 at the STAPLES Center in Los Angeles, CA, with coverage on TNT and ESPN Radio beginning at 7 p.m.

* Joe Johnson needs six assists to tie Hall-of-Famer Dominique Wilkins for sixth on the Hawks' all-time list at 2321. Another Hall of Fame member, Bob Pettit, is fifth on the list with 2369 assists.

* Hawks 2010 second round draft pick Pape Sy is averaging 8.4 ppg, 3.6 rpg and 1.6 apg (.402 FG%, .735 FT%) in 16 games (10 starting assignments) for the Utah Flash of the NBA Development League.

* Atlanta used their eighth different starting lineup of the year at Washington on 2/5. The opening night starters – Marvin Williams, Josh Smith, Al Horford, Joe Johnson and Mike Bibby – have started only 20-of-51 games together this season, posting a 14-6 record (.700 winning percentage).

* Al Horford missed the Hawks' game at Washington on 2/5 with a sore back. He is listed as day-to-day.

* Atlanta hosted the largest crowd of the season at Philips Arena (19,363) on 2/4 vs. the Los Angeles Clippers and has sold out two-of-the last-three home games (also 19,069 vs. New York on 1/28).

* The NBA has announced that the Atlanta Hawks vs. New York Knicks game on Sunday, 3/6 will now be shown nationally by ESPN. The game, originally set for a 6 p.m. start, will now move to 6:30. The Hawks' local TV network, SportSouth, will also televise the game in the metro Atlanta and surrounding area.
