UPCOMING GAMES



Tuesday, Mar. 15, 2011 vs. Milwaukee Bucks (7 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM

Atlanta hosts Milwaukee for the second time this year in the fourth-and-final meeting between the teams ... The game was originally scheduled for 1/11 but was postponed due to inclement weather ... The Bucks have taken two-of-three games with the Hawks, including the last contest at Philips Arena on 11/10 (108-91) ... The teams split two games in Milwaukee, with Atlanta winning 95-80 on 12/27 and the Bucks taking a 98-90 decision on 1/26 ... The Bucks lead the all-time series 98-93 but Atlanta holds a 61-35 advantage in home games.



Wednesday, Mar. 16, 2011 vs. Denver Nuggets (7 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM

Denver comes to Philips Arena for the only time this year in the second-and-final game against the Hawks ... The Nuggets took the first meeting, 100-90, on 2/28 behind 19 points from J.R. Smith ... Joe Johnson's 22 points led Atlanta, and Al Horford had 21 points and 16 boards ... Denver has now won two straight overall in the series but Atlanta has taken three-in-a-row at Philips Arena ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 40-33, including a 27-6 home record.



Friday, Mar. 18, 2011 vs. Miami Heat (7:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM

The Hawks host the Heat for the first time this year in the third-of-four contests between the clubs ... Miami returns to Philips Arena on 4/11 to finish the season series ... The teams have split two games in Miami this year, with the Heat winning 89-77 on 12/4 before Atlanta evened things up with a 93-89 triumph on 1/18 ... The Heat won the last meeting at Philips Arena, 94-76, on 2/10/10 ... Miami leads the all-time series 46-39, with Atlanta holding a 27-14 edge in home games.



Sunday, Mar. 20, 2011 vs. Detroit Pistons (2 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM

Detroit visits Atlanta for second time this year in the fourth-and-final matchup between the rivals ... The Hawks have taken two-of-three games against the Pistons this season, including a 94-85 win at Philips Arena on 11/3 ... The teams split two games in Detroit, with the Pistons posting a 103-80 decision on 12/14 and Atlanta winning 94-79 on 2/14 ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 163-158 (70-77 at home).

- * The Hawks-Bucks game originally scheduled for 1/11 will be played on Tuesday, 3/15 at Philips Arena. Tipoff is set for 7 p.m. The game will be broadcast on SportSouth HD and 97.9 FM (99X).
- * On 3/12 vs. Portland, Joe Johnson moved past Hall-of-Famer Bob Pettit into fifth place on the Hawks' all-time assist chart (now at 2370).
- * Against Portland on 3/12, second year guard Jeff Teague tallied 24 points (11-17 FGs, 1-2 3FGs, 1-4 FTs), 5 steals, 4 rebounds, 3 assists and 3 blocks, setting or tying career-highs in points, FGM, steals and blocks.
- * Al Horford missed the Hawks-Trail Blazers game on 3/12 due to a left ankle injury. He status is currently listed as day-to-day.

THIS WEEK IN HAWKS HISTORY

March 14, 1997 – Steve Smith sets a franchise record by hitting 9 three-pointers in a 97-91 home loss to Seattle. He finished the night with 36 points on 10-20 FGs, 9-15 3FGs and 7-7 FTs. Smith also set records for three's in a half (7) and a quarter (7) which were later tied by Henry James.
