UPCOMING GAMES



Wednesday, Mar. 30, 2011 vs. Orlando Magic (7 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM

The Hawks host Orlando for the second time this year in the fourth-and-final game between the teams ... The Magic posted a 93-89 home win in the first meeting this season (11/8), but Atlanta has taken the last two contests – an 80-74 road triumph on 12/6 and a 91-81 victory at Philips Arena on 12/20 ... Josh Smith has recorded a double-double in all three games against Orlando, and is averaging 14.7 ppg and 12.0 rpg in the season series ... Dwight Howard owns three double-doubles against the Hawks this year, and is averaging 20.0 ppg and 14.7 rpg in the season series ... Atlanta has taken two straight games against Orlando at Philips Arena ... The Magic lead the all-time series 45-39, with Atlanta holding a 26-15 edge in home games.



Friday, Apr. 1, 2011 vs. Boston Celtics (8 p.m.)
TV: ESPN ... Radio: 97.9 FM

Boston visits Atlanta for the second time this year in the third-and-final meeting between the rivals ... The Celtics are 2-0 against the Hawks this season, winning once on the road (99-76 on 11/22) and once at home (102-90 on 12/16) ... Marvin Williams scored a season-high 26 points to lead the Hawks in game two ... Kevin Garnett owns two double-doubles against Atlanta this year, and is averaging 17.0 ppg and 12.5 rpg in the season series ... The Celtics lead the all-time series 216-130, but the Hawks hold an 82-79 advantage in home games.



Sunday, Apr. 3, 2011 at Houston Rockets (7 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM

Atlanta heads to Houston for the only time this year in the second-and-final contest between the clubs ... The Rockets knocked off the Hawks, 112-106, at Philips Arena on 1/15 in game one ... Six Rockets scored in double-figures, led by Aaron Brooks' 24 points and 10 assists ... Joe Johnson paced Atlanta with 30 points, while Al Horford (24 points/10 rebounds) and Josh Smith (21 points/12 boards) each had 20/10 games ... The Hawks won the last meeting in Houston, 102-95, on 1/25/10 ... The all-time series is deadlocked at 69 wins apiece, with the Rockets leading 48-20 in home games.

NEWS & NOTES

* Atlanta clinched a playoff berth for the fourth straight year after knocking off New Jersey 98-87 at Philips Arena on 3/26. It is tied for the second longest active streak in the Eastern Conference (with Boston), trailing Orlando at five consecutive seasons. The Hawks are currently the fifth seed in the East.

* Joe Johnson missed the Hawks game at Cleveland on 3/27 due to a sprained right thumb. His status is currently listed as day-to-day.

* Marvin Williams scored a season-best 31 points at Cleveland on 3/27, while also setting or tying season-highs in made field goals (9), three-point field goals (3) and free throws (10).

* Jeff Teague knocked down a career-high 4-4 three-point field goals en route to 20 points versus Chicago on 3/22.

* Jamal Crawford made his 4000th career field goal versus New Jersey on 3/26.

* Kirk Hinrich has not committed a turnover in the last three games, while dishing out 17 assists (103 minutes of playing time).

* On 4/5, prior to the Hawks vs. Spurs game (7 p.m. tipoff), the Atlanta Hawks will host a Career and Internship Fair at Philips Arena.
