GAME ONE RECAP

The Hawks rolled into a hostile environment in Orlando and came away with their first game 1 road win since 1996, downing the Magic, 103-93, at Amway Center on Saturday ... Joe Johnson (25) and Jamal Crawford (23) led a balanced Atlanta attack, aided by Al Horford (16), Josh Smith (15) and Kirk Hinrich (13) ... Dwight Howard scored 31 of his 46 points in the opening half adding 19 rebounds, but also committing 8 turnovers ... Jameer Nelson scored 27, including 20 in the 3rd quarter ... Atlanta rode an early 9-0 run to take a 13-5 lead, but the Magic came back to snag a 19-17 advantage after one ... The Hawks caught fire in the second quarter, hitting 14-18 FGs (.778), scoring 38 points ... Howard was virtually unstoppable in the half, scoring Orlando's first 12 points, and 31 total at the midway point, a Magic playoff record ... In the third quarter, Atlanta put together a 13-1 run to push the lead to as many as 17 ... Nelson came alive for the Magic, scoring 20 points in the quarter, also a team mark, but the Hawks still led 85-71 entering the fourth ... Atlanta pushed the advantage up to 18 and hung on late.

REGULAR SEASON SERIES

The Hawks and Magic match-up in the playoffs after meeting four times during the regular season ... Atlanta took three-of-four regular season meetings, including both contests at Philips Arena (91-81 on 12/20 and 85-82 on 3/30) ... The teams split two games at Amway Center, with Orlando winning 93-89 on 11/8 and the Hawks taking an 80-74 decision on 12/6 ... Joe Johnson scored at a 19.3 ppg clip against the Magic this year, while Josh Smith averaged a double-double (17.5 ppg/10.5 rpg), and Al Horford put in 16.8 ppg on .580 FG shooting ... Orlando's Dwight Howard averaged 19.2 ppg and 14.2 rpg against the Hawks on the season and Jameer Nelson scored 19.0 ppg in the two contests he played ... Atlanta has now won three straight regular season home games against Orlando.

* The Hawks are hosting a Playoff Viewing Party presented by Budweiser for Game Two of their first round playoff series against the Orlando Magic. Fans are invited to the Hudson Grille Brookhaven, Hudson Grille Midtown and the Cheyenne Grille in Buckhead on 4/19 (7:30 p.m. tipoff) for the Game Two party. Festivities will include appearances by the Budweiser Promo Team, Hawks-themed contests, trivia, giveaways, and more. FOX Sports South HD, NBA TV and 99X (97.9 FM) are broadcasting the contest.

NEWS & NOTES

* On 4/11, Atlanta signed free agent forward Magnum Rolle. He did not see any game action with the Hawks after being placed on the Inactive List for the final two regular season games. The 6'11 forward appeared in five preseason games for Indiana before being waived on 10/25/10. Rolle was the 51st overall pick in the 2010 NBA Draft, selected by Oklahoma City. He was then acquired by the Pacers in exchange for the draft rights to Ryan Reid. The Gatorade callup played in 15 games (7 starts) with the Maine Red Claws of the NBA Development League this season, averaging 14.1 ppg, 5.5 rpg, 1.5 spg, 1.3 apg and 1.2 bpg (.508 FG%, .585 FT%). He was the 3rd overall pick of the D-League Draft by the Claws.

* Several Hawks finished the regular season ranked among the NBA's best in a number of statistical categories: Jamal Crawford was 22nd in FT% (.854); Kirk Hinrich ranked 32nd in 3FG% (.399) and 38th in apg (4.0); Al Horford finished 5th in FG% (.557), 19th in double-doubles (36), 16th in efficiency (22.5), 28th in bpg (1.0), 11th in rpg (9.3), 7th in def. rpg (7.0) and 24th in off. rpg (2.4); Joe Johnson was 28th in ppg (18.2) and 31st in apg (4.7); Josh Smith ended up 13th in double-doubles (31), 14th in total blocks (120), 15th in bpg (1.6), 18th in rpg (8.5), 9th in def. rpg (6.8), 24th in spg (1.3), 24th in efficiency (20.5) and 35th in ppg (16.5); Marvin Williams ranked 33rd in FT% (.845).

* Jamal Crawford and Joe Johnson are among the top active career three-point shooters in the NBA. Crawford has made 1307 in his 11-year career to rank 13th among active players, while Johnson has sunk 1156 from long range in 10 seasons, which puts him tied for 18th.
