#### SERIES RECAP

The Hawks hold a 3-1 lead in the best-of-seven first round series with the Magic ... The teams split the first two contests in Orlando, with Atlanta taking game one 103-93 before the Magic evened things with an 88-82 triumph ... The Hawks won games three and four at Philips Arena (88-84 and 88-85) ... Jamal Crawford has topped the 20-point mark off the bench in all four games, becoming the third NBA player in the last 20 season to accomplish the feat ... He's averaging a team-high 24.0 ppg and hitting .565 from three-point range (13-23) ... Joe Johnson has put in at least 20 points in three-of-four games and is averaging 20.0 ppg ... Johnson and Crawford are also tied for the team-lead at 4.0 apg ... Al Horford has recorded two double-doubles and is averaging 13.3 ppg and a team-best 8.8 rpg, while Josh Smith (one double-double) is contributing 14.0 ppg and 8.5 rpg ... Atlanta is shooting .447 FG% and .397 3FG% in the series compared to the Magic's .403 and .219 (21-96) ... The Hawks held Orlando to 2-23 three-point shooting (.087) in Game 4 ... Dwight Howard is leading the Magic with 32.3 ppg and 17.5 rpg (recording a double-double in each outing) on .667 FG% ... Jameer Nelson is the only other Orlando player in double-figures at 14.8 ppg.

#### REGULAR SEASON SERIES

The Hawks and Magic match-up in the playoffs after meeting four times during the regular season ... Atlanta took three-of-four regular season meetings, including both contests at Philips Arena (91-81 on 12/20 and 85-82 on 3/30) ... The teams split two games at Amway Center, with Orlando winning 93-89 on 11/8 and the Hawks taking an 80-74 decision on 12/6 ... Joe Johnson scored at a 19.3 ppg clip against the Magic this year, while Josh Smith averaged a double-double (17.5 ppg/10.5 rpg), and Al Horford put in 16.8 ppg on .580 FG shooting ... Orlando's Dwight Howard averaged 19.2 ppg and 14.2 rpg against the Hawks on the season and Jameer Nelson scored 19.0 ppg in the two contests he played ... Atlanta has now won three straight regular season home games against Orlando.

### COMMUNITY NEWS

\* The Hawks are hosting a Playoff Viewing Party presented by Budweiser for Game 5 of their first round playoff series against the Orlando Magic. Fans are invited to the Hudson Grille Brookhaven, Hudson Grille Midtown and the Cheyenne Grille in Buckhead on 4/26 (7:30 p.m. tipoff) for the Game 5 party. Festivities will include appearances by the Budweiser Promo Team, Hawks-themed contests, trivia, giveaways, and more. Admission is free. FOX Sports South HD or SportSouth HD, NBA TV and 99X (97.9 FM) are broadcasting the contest.

### NEWS & NOTES

\* Several Hawks have set or tied single game playoff career-highs in a number of categories during their first round series with Orlando: Jamal Crawford – points (25 twice), FGM (10), 3FGM (4) and assists (6); Marvin Williams – assists (2) and steals (2 twice); Joe Johnson – rebounds (9); Al Horford – minutes (45); Zaza Pachulia – assists (3); Jason Collins – steals (3); Kirk Hinrich – blocks (2); Hilton Armstrong – steals (2).

\* Jamal Crawford has scored 20-plus points in each of the first four games of the first round playoff series with Orlando. He is the third NBA player to accomplish the feat in the last 20 seasons, joining Hawks Player Development Instructor Nick Van Exel (with Dallas in 2003) and Kevin McHale (Boston in 1991).

\* Over the last two contests (Games 3 and 4) at Philips Arena, the Magic have held the lead three times (all in the fourth quarter of Game 3) for a total of one minute and 11 seconds.

\* The Hawks have held a double-digit lead in each of the four games of their first round playoff series with Orlando.

\* Joe Johnson has moved into fourth place on the Hawks' all-time postseason assists chart at 138, passing Walt Hazzard (124) and Dominique (135). He's also tied with Randy Wittman for 6<sup>th</sup> all-time in made field goals (224).

\* Josh Smith ranks sixth on the Hawks' all-time postseason made free throws list with 124.

\* Jamal Crawford ranks 9<sup>th</sup> in the NBA in playoff scoring at 24.0 ppg and Joe Johnson is 17<sup>th</sup> at 20.0 ppg. Al Horford sits in 14<sup>th</sup> in postseason rebounding (8.8) while Josh Smith is 15<sup>th</sup> (8.8). Crawford is also 9<sup>th</sup> in 3FG% (.565), and he and Johnson are tied for 18<sup>th</sup> in assists (4.0).
