UPCOMING GAMES



Tuesday, Apr. 5, 2011 vs. San Antonio Spurs (7 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM

San Antonio visits Philips Arena for the only time this year in the second-and-final game against the Hawks ... The Spurs took a 108-92 home decision in game one on 12/10 ... Six Spurs scored in double-figures that night and DeJuan Blair posted a double-double (16 points/12 rebounds) ... Jamal Crawford's 23 points paced the Hawks ... The teams split last season's series at one game apiece, each winning at home ... San Antonio leads the all-time series 41-36, with Atlanta holding a 24-14 advantage in home games.



Friday, Apr. 8, 2011 at Indiana Pacers (7 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM

The Hawks head to Indiana for the second time in the fourth-and-final meeting with the Pacers ... Atlanta is 3-0 so far against Indiana, posting a 102-92 road win on 11/16 and two home triumphs on 12/11 (97-83) and 1/8 (108-93) ... Josh Smith is averaging 24.3 ppg versus the Pacers this year and has topped 20 points in each game ... The Hawks currently own a nine-game win streak in the series (swept Indiana 3-0 last season), including three straight road wins ... Indiana's last win against Atlanta was a 113-96 home decision on 11/18/08 ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 88-73, with the Pacers holding a 48-32 edge in home games.



Saturday, Apr. 9, 2011 at Washington Wizards (7 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 97.9 FM

Atlanta visits the nation's capital for the second time in the fourth-and-final contest with the Wizards ... The Hawks are 3-0 against Washington and are looking to sweep the season series for the third consecutive year ... Atlanta has won 12 consecutive games against Washington, including seven straight on the road ... The Wizards' last win in the series was a 102-98 (OT) decision at Philips Arena on 1/11/08 and their last home win came on 3/2/07 (93-92) ... Josh Smith is averaging 20.3 ppg and 13.3 rpg against Washington this year and has recorded a double-double in all three games ... Joe Johnson has topped 20 points three times and is averaging 22.3ppg, while Al Horford is putting up 18.0 ppg and 11.5 rpg (two double-doubles) in two contests, missing game three due to injury ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 138-132 (44-85 on the road).

* Prior to the Hawks-Spurs game (7 p.m. tipoff) at Philips Arena on 4/5, the organization will announce the winner of this year's Jason Collier Memorial Trophy. The Jason Collier Memorial Trophy, named after the late Hawks center who passed away October 15, 2005, is presented annually to the individual who best exemplifies the characteristics Collier displayed off the court as a community ambassador.

* The National Basketball Association (NBA), in partnership with the Natural Resources Defense Council (NRDC), has announced that NBA Green Week 2011 will tip off 4/3. The Hawks have a number of things planned for the week, including: An Electronics Drive at Philips Arena (in conjunction with Georgia's Own) from 3-7 p.m. on 4/5 prior to the Hawks-Spurs game; In partnership with Waste Management, a team of ushers will walk the aisles at a designated timeout during the Hawks-Spurs games to collect plastic bottles and cups from fans for recycling; The organization will present a check for \$10,000 to Trees Atlanta, through a program presented by The Home Depot, at the 4/5 game to plant and maintain trees in areas of need; Several Hawks players are committed to do a tree mulching service project on 4/6 in Vine City. * SportSouth announced has announced that the network will televise the Hawks vs. Bobcats game in Charlotte on Wednesday, 4/13 at 8 p.m. ET in high definition. With the addition of the 4/13 game, SportSouth will televise a total of 76 regular-season Hawks games during the 2010-11 NBA season.

* The Hawks currently maintain the fifth seed in the Eastern Conference for the 2011 NBA Playoffs. Atlanta is 4.0 games behind fourth seeded Orlando and 4.0 games ahead of the sixth seeded Philadelphia. All three teams have five games left to play.

* Guard Jamal Crawford's appearance on BET's "The Mo'Nique Show" will air on Wednesday, 4/6 at 11 p.m.
