#### ALL-TIME SERIES RECAP

The Hawks and Bulls square-off in the postseason for the fourth time since the Hawks moved to Atlanta and the fifth time overall ... The Hawks took a Western Division Semifinals series, 4-1, in 1969-70 but the Bulls have won the last two postseason meetings – Eastern Conference First Round in 1992-93 (3-0) and the Eastern Conference Semifinals in 1996-97 (4-1) ... Additionally, the St. Louis Hawks beat Chicago 3-0 in the 1966-67 Western Division Semifinals ... The Bulls lead the all-time regular season series 113-100, but the Hawks hold a 59-45 advantage in home games ... Atlanta has dropped two straight regular season games at the United Center, with their last win coming on 3/1/10 (116-92).

#### 2010-11 REGULAR SEASON SERIES

Chicago took the season series 2-1 including a win at Philips Arena ... The Hawks posted an 83-80 home win in game one on 3/2, coming back from a 19-point deficit ... Al Horford led the way with a career-high-tying 31 points and 16 rebounds, while Luol Deng paced the Bulls with 15 points ... Chicago won the next two, recording a 94-76 home victory on 3/11 and 114-81 triumph at Philips Arena on 3/22 ... Derrick Rose led all scorers in game two with 34 points and Joe Johnson had 16 for Atlanta ... Rose went for 30 points in game three and Deng added 27 ... Jeff Teague was the top scorer for the Hawks with 20 points, including a career-best 4-4 showing from three-point range ... Three Hawks averaged double-figures in scoring against Chicago this year – Horford (17.0), Josh Smith (14.5) and Joe Johnson (13.7) ... Rose (25.3) and Deng (20.0) were the Bulls' scoring leaders against the Hawks.

### COMMUNITY NEWS

\* The Hawks are hosting a Playoff Viewing Party presented by Budweiser for Game 5 of their Eastern Conference Semifinals series against the Chicago Bulls. Fans are invited to the Hudson Grille Brookhaven, Hudson Grille Midtown and the Cheyenne Grille in Buckhead on 5/10 for all the festivities, including appearances by the Budweiser Promo Team, Hawks-themed contests, trivia, giveaways, and more. Admission is free. TNT and 99X (97.9 FM) are broadcasting the contest.

### NEWS & NOTES

\* Hawks postseason statistical leaders include: Joe Johnson with 19.2 ppg, 1.20 spg, 41.5 mpg and .485 3FG%; Al Horford with 10.1 rpg and 3.8 apg; Jeff Teague at .491 FG% and .875 FT%; Josh Smith at 2.00 bpg.

\* Jeff Teague has set or tied playoff career-highs in virtually every statistical category during the Eastern Conference Semifinals versus Chicago, including 21 points (twice), 4 rebounds (5/8), 5 assists (5/2), 3 steals (5/4), 2 blocks (5/4), 8 FGM (5/6), 6 FTM (5/4) and 45 minutes (5/2). Other Hawks reaching postseason career-bests are Josh Smith with 16 rebounds (5/8), Al Horford handing out 6 assists (5/4), Joe Johnson swiping 5 steals (5/4), Marvin Williams posting 2 blocks (twice) and Jamal Crawford with 2 steals (5/8).

\* Several Hawks have cracked the team's all-time postseason games played list. Joe Johnson and Josh Smith have participated in 39 games which is tied for 6<sup>th</sup> with Spud Webb. Zaza Pachulia ranks 9<sup>th</sup> with 38 games played and Al Horford is 10<sup>th</sup> at 37.

\* Joe Johnson has moved into 6<sup>th</sup> place on Atlanta's all-time playoff scoring leaders chart with 709 points. He also ranks 4<sup>th</sup> in assists (155) and FGM (268), and 5<sup>th</sup> in FTM (120). Josh Smith has jumped to 4<sup>th</sup> in FTM (150) and 7<sup>th</sup> in rebounds (316), while Al Horford is 6<sup>th</sup> in rebounds (325).

\* Joe Johnson ranks 18<sup>th</sup> in the NBA in playoff scoring at 19.2 ppg and 7<sup>th</sup> in mpg (41.5); Al Horford is 8<sup>th</sup> in rebounding (10.1), 17<sup>th</sup> in apg (3.8) and 6<sup>th</sup> in A/TO ratio (3.17); Josh Smith ranks 5<sup>th</sup> in bpg (2.0) and 16<sup>th</sup> in rpg (9.0); Jamal Crawford is 20<sup>th</sup> in ppg (20.5).

\* With enhanced security measures in place at Philips Arena for the remainder of the NBA Playoffs, fans are strongly encouraged to arrive early for games to ensure a smooth and timely entry into the building. All guests will be screened via wand metal detectors, in addition to standard bag search procedures. Doors will open 90 minutes prior to games.

Fifth-seeded Atlanta advanced to the Eastern Conference Semifinals against the number one seed Chicago Bulls with a 4-2 First Round Series win over Orlando. The Hawks and Bulls are tied at two games apiece with Game 5 set for Tuesday in Chicago.
