UPCOMING GAMES



Tuesday, Jan. 31, 2012 at Toronto Raptors (7 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM

Atlanta heads north of the border for the first time this year in the second-of-four games against Toronto ... The Hawks came away with a 93-84 home win in game one (1/16) behind 28 points and 15 rebounds from Josh Smith, and Joe Johnson's 27 points ... Leandro Barbosa paced the Raptors with 22 points ... The teams finish the season series with a back-to-back home and home set on 4/15 (at Philips Arena) and 4/16 (at Air Canada Centre) ... Atlanta currently owns a five-game winning streak against the Raptors, including taking the last two in Canada ... Toronto's last win in the series was a 106-105 home triumph on 3/17/10 ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 35-26, including a 16-14 road mark.



Thursday, Feb. 2, 2012 vs. Memphis Grizzlies (7:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM

The Hawks host the Grizzlies in the only game between the clubs this year ... Atlanta has swept the season series each of the last two years (4-0) and currently has a five-game winning streak at Philips Arena against Memphis ... The Grizzlies' last win against the Hawks was a 98-90 home decision on 4/15/09 and their last victory at Philips Arena came on 11/12/05 (85-84) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 21-10, including a 13-3 advantage at home.



Saturday, Feb. 4, 2012 vs. Philadelphia 76ers (7 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM

Philadelphia comes to Philips Arena for the only time this year in the second-of-three contests with the Hawks ... The Sixers took game one, a 90-76 home win, on 1/20 ... Thaddeus Young scored a game-high 20 points while Elton Brand added 10 points and 16 boards ... Willie Green led the Hawks with 14 points off the bench ... Atlanta visits Philadelphia on 3/31 to close out the season series ... The 76ers have taken three-in-a-row against Atlanta, including the last meeting at Philips Arena (117-83) on 2/8/11 ... Atlanta's last win against Philly was a 93-88 home decision on 12/3/10 ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 157-155 (96-50 at home).

NEWS & NOTES

* Kirk Hinrich made his season debut on 1/25 at San Antonio, finishing with 7 points (3-4 FGs, 1-1 3FGs) and 1 steal in 13 minutes of action. Hinrich missed the first 18 games of the year recuperating from left shoulder surgery in early November.

* On 1/26, Atlanta requested waivers on guard Donald Sloan. The undrafted rookie out of Texas A&M saw action in five games this season, averaging 1.2 ppg, 1.0 apg and 1.0 rpg (.375 FG%).

* Josh Smith moved into 10th place on the Hawks' all-time rebounding list (currently at 4330), surpassing Dikembe Mutombo at Detroit on 1/27. Smith has also moved into 7th on the offensive rebounding chart (1179), ahead of Cliff Levingston on 1/29 at New Orleans, and into 4th in defensive rebounding (3151) versus Cleveland on 1/21.

* Joe Johnson scored his 14,000th career point at Detroit on 1/27, while Willie Green grabbed career rebound 1000 at New Orleans on 1/29.

* In their 107-101 overtime win at Detroit on 1/27, the Hawks tied a franchise record by scoring 20 points in the extra session (previously on 4/2/08 vs. Toronto). Atlanta knocked down 6-7 FGs, 2-3 3FGs and 6-10 FTs during the frame.

* Jeff Teague tied career-highs in points (24) and 3FGM (4-4) at New Orleans on 1/29, while equaling a season-best with 9 FGM.

* Marvin Williams knocked down a career-high 5 3FGs on his way to a season-best 22 points at Detroit on 1/27. He also tied his season-high with 6 FGM.

February 5, 1972 – Pete Maravich scores 50 points in Atlanta's 120-117 home win over Cleveland. It is tied for the ninth-highest single game scoring effort in franchise history. Maravich's 20 made field goals (20-27) are tied for sixth on the club's all-time list.
