### UPCOMING GAMES



**Monday, Feb. 6, 2012 vs. Phoenix Suns (7:30 p.m.)**  
**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM**

The Suns visit Philips Arena for the only time this year in the first-of-two games with the Hawks ... Atlanta goes to Phoenix on 2/15 to finish the season series ... The Suns swept last year's series, 2-0, including a 118-114 road win on 11/7 ... Phoenix currently owns a three-game winning streak against Atlanta overall ... The Hawks' last win against the Suns was a 102-101 home triumph on 1/15/10 ... The Suns lead the all-time series 65-47, while the Hawks hold a 29-24 edge in home games.



**Wednesday, Feb. 8, 2012 vs. Indiana Pacers (7:30 p.m.)**  
**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM**

The Pacers come to Philips Arena for the only time this year in the second-of-three meetings with the Hawks ... Indiana posted a 96-84 home win in game one behind Danny Granger's 24 points ... Josh Smith led four Hawks in double-figures with 16 points ... The Hawks return to Indiana on 3/6 to close-out the season series ... The Pacers have taken the last two games against the Hawks (both at home) but Atlanta has won eight-in-a-row at Philips Arena ... Indiana's last win in Atlanta came on 12/22/06 (100-90) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 88-75, including a 55-25 home record.



**Friday, Feb. 10, 2012 at Orlando Magic (7 p.m.)**  
**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM**

The Hawks and Magic meet for the first-of-three games this year and the first-of-two in Orlando ... The Magic come to Philips Arena on 2/23 before hosting Atlanta on 4/13 to finish the season series ... The Hawks took last year's series, 3-1, winning each of the final three contests, including an 80-74 road triumph on 12/6/10 ... Atlanta also eliminated Orlando from the 2011 NBA Playoffs with a 4-1 series win in round one ... The Magic lead the all-time series 45-40 (30-13 at home).



**Sunday, Feb. 12, 2012 vs. Miami Heat (7 p.m.)**  
**TV: SportSouth HD/ESPN ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM**

Miami comes to Philips Arena for the second-and-final time in the third-of-four games with Atlanta ... The teams have split two games so far this year, each winning on the road ... The Hawks posted a 100-92 win on 1/2 behind Joe Johnson's 21 points ... LeBron James scored 28 to lead Miami ... The Heat evened things up in triple overtime on 1/5 (116-109) thanks to Chris Bosh (33 points/14 rebounds) ... Johnson led six Hawks in double-figures with 20 points ... The clubs square off again on 3/7 in Miami to finish the season series ... Miami leads the all-time series 49-40, with the Hawks holding a 27-17 lead in home games.

### NEWS & NOTES

\* Jason Collins, who suffered a sprained left elbow on 2/2 against Memphis, will miss a minimum of two weeks of action, according to Head Athletic Trainer Wally Blase. Collins will be re-evaluated at that time.

\* On 1/31, the McDonald's All American Games unveiled its list of 35 of the Greatest McDonald's All Americans, released in celebration of the 35<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the McDonald's All American High School Boys Basketball Game. Hawks guard Jerry Stackhouse and Hall of Famer Dominique Wilkins were both on the list.

\* The Hawks went 4-1 on their recently completed five-game road trip. The 4-1 record marked the best Atlanta five-game road trip since going 5-0 on a trip in December of 1968, the team's first season in Atlanta.

\* Against Philadelphia on 2/4, Ivan Johnson set career-highs with 14 points (career-best 7-11 FGs) and 13 rebounds, while Jeff Teague tied his career-high by hitting 7-8 FTs on his way to 21 points.

\* Among all NBA rookies, Ivan Johnson ranks 6<sup>th</sup> in FT% (.821), 10<sup>th</sup> in rpg (4.0) and 19<sup>th</sup> in scoring (5.8).

\* Atlanta went 13-5 in the month of January, recording their most wins in a month since a 14-2 mark in January of 1997, a span of 15 years.

\* The Hawks-Pacers game on 2/8 features the Aaron's Lucky Dog Wednesday's promotion, and includes an upper level ticket and \$50 Aaron's gift card starting at \$15.

### THIS WEEK IN HAWKS HISTORY

**February 11, 1970** – The Hawks tie the franchise record for points in a game in a 155-131 road win over San Diego. The record was originally set by the St. Louis Hawks on Jan. 24, 1960 against the Knicks.
