UPCOMING GAMES



Tuesday, Mar. 6, 2012 at Indiana Pacers (7 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM

Atlanta travels to Indiana for the second time this year in the third-and-final game between the clubs ... The teams split the first two meetings, each winning at home ... The Pacers struck first with a 96-84 decision on 1/11, behind 24 points from Danny Granger ... Josh Smith's 16 points led Atlanta ... The Hawks evened things up with 97-87 win on 2/8 as Smith posted 28 points and 12 rebounds ... Granger was the top scorer for Indiana with 21 ... The Hawks have dropped two straight games in Indiana, with their last road win coming on 11/16/10 (102-92) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 89-75 (32-50 on the road).



Wednesday, Mar. 7, 2012 at Miami Heat (7:30 p.m.)

The Hawks head to Miami for the second time this year in the fourth-and-final contest between the teams ... The Heat lead the season series 2-1, winning twice at Philips Arena – 116-109 in triple OT on 1/5 and 107-87 on 2/12 ... Atlanta recorded a 100-92 triumph in Miami on 1/2 ... Joe Johnson is averaging 17.7 ppg in this year's series while Chris Bosh is putting up 22.0 ppg and 12.0 rpg versus Atlanta ... The Hawks have posted two straight wins in Miami, with the Heat's last home victory coming on 12/4/10 (89-77) ... Miami leads the all-time series 50-40, including a 32-13 home mark.



Friday, Mar. 9, 2012 at Detroit Pistons (7:30 p.m.)

Atlanta visits Detroit for the second time this year in the second-of-four games between the clubs ... The Hawks notched a 107-101 OT win in game one on 1/27 ... Joe Johnson scored a game-high 30 points, while Marvin Williams put in 22 and Josh Smith added 19 and 11 boards ... Greg Monroe led six Pistons in double-figures with 22 points and 11 rebounds ... Detroit comes to Philips Arena on 4/6 and 4/18 to finish the season series ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 165-158, including an 80-70 road record.



Sunday, Mar. 11, 2012 at Sacramento Kings (9 p.m.)

The Kings host the Hawks in the only match-up between the teams this year ... The Hawks swept last season's series, 2-0, including a 108-102 road decision on 1/4 ... Atlanta currently owns a seven-game winning streak against the Kings and has taken the last three meetings in Sacramento ... The Kings' last win in the series was a 119-107 home triumph on 2/20/08 ... Sacramento leads the all-time series 152-149 (71-41 at home).

- * Joe Johnson moved passed Eddie Johnson into seventh place on the Hawks' all-time field goals made list (currently at 3,804) versus Golden State on 2/29.
- * On 3/1, Atlanta signed center Erick Dampier for the remainder of the season. The 15-year veteran has appeared in six games for the Hawks this year, after signing consecutive 10-day contracts on 2/9 and 2/19.
- * The Atlanta Sports Council hosted the seventh annual Atlanta Sports Awards at the Fox Theatre on 2/27. Hawks legend Dominique Wilkins was presented with the 2012 Lifetime Achievement Award, while Al Horford was named Sports Person of the Year. - * The Hawks knocked off Oklahoma City at Philips Arena on 3/3, in the process becoming the only team in the NBA this year to have defeated the Thunder, Chicago Bulls and Miami Heat.
- * Jason Collins (sprained left elbow), Willie Green (lower back spasms), Al Horford (left pectoral surgery) and Joe Johnson (left knee tendinitis) all missed Atlanta's last game against Oklahoma City on 3/3, while Tracy McGrady (left knee strain) was injured in the first quarter that night.
- * With the rash of injuries that has hit the club this season, the Hawks have been forced to use eight different starting lineups. Only Josh Smith and Jeff Teague have started every game.
- * Josh Smith owns 11 20-point scoring efforts this season, including three 30-point nights. The Hawks are undefeated when Smith scores 20-plus (11-0).
