### UPCOMING GAMES



**Tuesday, Apr. 24, 2012 vs. Los Angeles Clippers (7:30 p.m.)**  
**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 98.9 FM**

The Clippers visit Philips Arena for the only time this year in the second-of-two games with the Hawks ... Los Angeles posted a 96-82 home win in the first meeting (3/14) behind 25 points from Mo Williams and Blake Griffin's double-double (12 points/10 boards) ... Joe Johnson paced Atlanta with 19 points while Zaza Pachulia added 12 points and 10 rebounds ... The win snapped the Hawks' four-game winning streak in the series ... Atlanta still owns a two-game home win streak against the Clippers, with L.A.'s last win at Philips Arena coming on 2/7/09 (121-97) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 70-37, including a 40-13 advantage at home.



**Thursday, Apr. 26, 2012 vs. Dallas Mavericks (8 p.m.)**  
**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM**

The defending NBA Champion Mavericks come to Philips Arena for the only match-up with the Hawks this year ... Dallas swept last season's series, 2-0, and has won three straight against the Hawks overall ... The last meeting between the clubs at Philips Arena (11/20/10) saw the Mavs come away with a 98-93 triumph ... Atlanta's last win over Dallas was a 80-75 road decision on 12/5/09 ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 31-10, including a 17-13 record at home.

### NEWS & NOTES

\* With a 109-97 win at Toronto on 4/16, Atlanta clinched a playoff berth for the fifth consecutive year. The Hawks are currently the fifth seed in the Eastern Conference.

\* The Hawks finished the road portion of the 2011-12 regular season schedule with a 17-16 record, marking the first time the club has finished above .500 away from home in 13 seasons (1998-99).

\* Josh Smith moved into 10<sup>th</sup> place on the Hawks' career games played list (currently 598) vs. Detroit on 4/18 and became the ninth Hawk to score 9,000 points (currently 9,003) vs. New York on 4/22.

\* Joe Johnson has scored 1,086 points this year, the ninth consecutive season he's gone over the 1,000 point mark.

\* Willie Green scored his 5,000<sup>th</sup> career point (currently 5,010) vs. Boston on 4/20.

\* Ivan Johnson set career-highs in a number of categories last week, including points (21), FGM (9) and FGA (13) at Toronto on 4/16, as well as minutes (33) and defensive rebounds (9) vs. Detroit on 4/18.

\* In Atlanta's 116-84 win over the Pistons on 4/18, the Hawks bench combined to score a season-best 72 points. Tracy McGrady led the way with a season-high 17 points, while Ivan Johnson scored 16, and Marvin Williams and Willie Green 10 apiece. Rounding out the reserves scoring was Jannero Pargo (9), Vladimir Radmanovic (7) and Jerry Stackhouse (3).
