SERIES RECAP

Boston holds a 3-1 lead in the best-of-seven first round series with Atlanta ... The teams split the first two games at Philips Arena, with the Hawks taking game one 83-74, and the Celtics winning game two 87-80 ... Despite a depleted roster (Al Horford, Zaza Pachulia and Josh Smith all missed the contest due to injury), Atlanta pushed the Celtics to overtime in game three before succumbing 90-84 ... Boston ran away with game four 101-79 and now stands one game away from advancing to the Eastern Conference Semifinals ... Joe Johnson is averaging 17.8 ppg in the series and Josh Smith is putting up 17.7 ppg, 14.3 rpg and 4.7 apg while recording three double-doubles ... Jeff Teague is also in double-figures at 15.8 ppg ... Paul Pierce is leading all scorers with 23.3 ppg ... Rajon Rondo (19.0 ppg/13.0 apg) and Kevin Garnett (17.0 ppg/10.5 rpg) are averaging double-doubles ... As a team, the Hawks are scoring 81.5 ppg on .385 FG%, while the Celtics are hitting .434 from the field and scoring 88.0 ppg ... The winner of the series moves on to face either Philadelphia or Chicago in the Eastern Conference Semifinals.

REGULAR SEASON SERIES

The Hawks and Celtics match-up after meeting three times during the regular season ... Boston took two-of-three against Atlanta after splitting two games at Philips Arena and winning the only contest in Beantown ... The Celtics posted a road win on 3/19 (79-76) and a home triumph on 4/11 (88-86 in overtime) before the Hawks managed a 97-92 decision at Philips Arena on 4/20 ... Joe Johnson tallied 23.0 ppg against Boston this year, while Josh Smith (16.3 ppg/11.3 rpg) and Zaza Pachulia (14.5 ppg/10.0 rpg in two games) each averaged a double-double ... Kevin Garnett (19.0 ppg/10.0 rpg) and Rajon Rondo (10.0 ppg/16.5 apg) also averaged double-doubles in the series, each seeing action in two games ... The Hawks are 132-218 all-time against Boston in the regular season (84-80 at home, 34-117 on the road) and 24-39 all-time in the postseason (including last night's loss).

NEWS & NOTES

- * Joe Johnson moved into third on Atlanta's all-time playoff field goals made list (currently 306) ahead of Kevin Willis and into fifth in games played (45) passing Celtics coach Doc Rivers at Boston on 5/6.
- * Josh Smith climbed several of Atlanta's all-time playoff charts at Boston on 5/6. Smith moved into a tie for second in free throws made (169) with Steve Smith, fourth in rebounds (371), a tie for fifth with Mookie Blaylock in field goals made (264), a tie for sixth with Celtics coach Doc Rivers in games played (44) and seventh in assists (122).
- * At Boston on 5/4, Jeff Teague set postseason career-highs with 23 points, 9 FGM, 47 minutes and 2 blocks (tied). He also tied a playoff career-best with 2 3FGM vs. Boston on 5/1.
- * Marvin Williams tied his postseason career-high with 11 rebounds at Boston on 5/4.
- * Al Horford returned to the active roster for game four at Boston (5/6) after missing the previous 58 games (55 regular season, 3 postseason) due to a torn left pectoral muscle and subsequent surgery. In 20 minutes off the bench, Horford tallied 12 points (6-10 FGs), 5 rebounds and 1 assist. It was his 40th career postseason game with Atlanta, tying him with teammate Zaza Pachulia for eighth on the club's all-time list.
- * Tracy McGrady ranks second among active NBA in players in playoff scoring at 26.3 ppg. Joe Johnson is 22nd in three-pointers made (83) and 20th in ppg (16.9). Jerry Stackhouse ranks 25th (79) in three-pointers and 16th in FT% (.830). Josh Smith is tied for 18th among active players in blocked shots (84).
