UPCOMING GAMES



Wednesday, Oct. 10, 2012 at San Antonio Spurs (8:30 p.m.)

TV: No local broadcast ... Radio: No local broadcast

Atlanta travels to San Antonio for the only game between the clubs in the preseason ... The teams will play twice during the 2012-13 regular season – at Philips Arena on 1/19 and at San Antonio on 4/6 ... The Spurs took the only contest versus Atlanta last year, a 105-83 home decision ... San Antonio currently owns a three-game winning streak against the Hawks, and has taken 14 straight at home ... The Spurs lead the all-time series 43-36, including a 28-12 home mark.



Sunday, Oct. 14, 2012 at Memphis Grizzlies (6 p.m.)

The Hawks head to Memphis for the only preseason match-up between the teams ... The clubs will meet twice during the 2012-13 regular season – at Memphis on 12/8 and at Philips Arena on 2/6 ... The Grizzlies won the only contest against the Hawks last year, 96-77, in Atlanta ... The Hawks own a two-game regular season road winning streak against Memphis ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 21-11, including an 8-7 road record.



Tuesday, Oct. 16, 2012 at Indiana Pacers (7 p.m.)

Atlanta visits Indiana in the only meeting between the clubs during the preseason ... The teams will match-up four times during the 2012-13 regular season – at Philips Arena on 11/7 and 12/29, and at Indiana on 2/5 and 3/25 ... The Hawks took the 2011-12 series, 2-1, splitting two road games and winning the lone contest at Philips Arena ... Atlanta has won two straight regular season games against the Pacers, including the last road contest ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 90-75 (33-50 on the road).

* The Hawks will bring back several ticket promotions for the 2012-13 season, including Chick-fil-A® Family Nights (four tickets and four Chick-fil-A® combo meal coupons starting at \$89), Aaron's Lucky Dog Wednesdays (fans can purchase a \$25 upper bowl ticket that includes \$10 for food and beverage), and military and college discounts are also available. * SportSouth will televise 75 Atlanta Hawks games throughout the 2012-13 NBA season, all in high definition. Hall of Famer Dominique Wilkins returns for his fifth season as the Hawks game analyst with play-by-play announcer Bob Rathbun, entering his 17th season as the voice of the Hawks. On the radio side, Steve Holman is back for his 28th year calling the action on 680 The Fan and 93.7 FM.

* Atlanta won its preseason opener, 92-79, vs. Miami at Philips Arena on 10/7. The Hawks trailed by 11 in the first quarter and by 10 with just over four minutes to play in the second, before finishing the half on a 14-2 run. Holding a 70-68 advantage early in the final quarter, Atlanta went on a 22-9 burst to put the game away.

* South Gwinnett High School alum Lou Williams made his debut in a Hawks uniform on 10/7 vs. Miami, finishing with 18 points (5-6 FGs, 2-3 3FGs, 6-9 FTs), one rebound, one assist, one steal and one block in 24 minutes off the bench.

* *DRIVEN: Danny Ferry and The New Look Hawks* premiered on 10/5 on FOX Sports South. Encore presentations will air throughout the month on FOX Sports South and SportSouth.
