UPCOMING GAMES



Monday, Nov. 12, 2012 at Portland Trail Blazers (10 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM

The Hawks head to Portland for the only time this year in the first-of-two games against the Trail Blazers ... Portland comes to Philips Arena on 3/22 to close-out the season series ... The teams split two contests last year, each winning at home ... Atlanta struck first with a 92-89 triumph on 1/18/12 and the Blazers evened things up with a 97-77 win on 2/18/12 ... The all-time series is deadlocked at 50 wins apiece, with Portland leading 33-17 in home games.



Wednesday, Nov. 14, 2012 at Golden State Warriors (10:30 p.m.)

Golden State hosts Atlanta for the only time this year in the first-of-two meetings between the clubs ... The Warriors visit Philips Arena on 12/15 to finish the season series ... Golden State won the only matchup against Atlanta last season, taking an 85-82 decision at Philips Arena on 2/29/12 ... The Hawks won their last road game in the series, 95-79, on 2/25/11 ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 141-135 with the Warriors holding a 74-44 advantage in home games.



Friday, Nov. 16, 2012 at Sacramento Kings (10 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM

The Hawks visit Sacramento for the only time this year in the first-of-two games with the Kings ... Sacramento comes to Philips Arena on 2/22 to finish the season series ... Atlanta took the only contest between the clubs last year, posting a 106-99 road decision on 3/11/12 ... The Hawks currently own an eight-game winning streak in the series and have taken four straight in Sacramento ... The Kings' last win against Atlanta came on 2/20/08 at home ... Sacramento leads the all-time series 152-150, including a 71-42 home mark.

COMMUNITY NEWS

* The Atlanta Hawks recognized Veteran's Day during Friday night's contest against Miami at Philips Arena ... In addition to a military-themed program cover and players wearing Veteran's Day inspired shooting shirts, headbands, wrist bands and socks, the Hawks conducted a moment of silence prior to tip, displayed a court-sized flag during the national anthem (performed by Tsgt. Audrey Latson), hosted a halftime show featuring an artist (David Garibaldi from America's Got Talent) creating a military-themed work of art, recognized all veterans in attendance during a timeout and encouraged fans to sign two large "thank you" cards.

NEWS & NOTES

* The Hawks bench has been outscored just once in five games, including a 47-28 advantage vs. Houston (11/2) and a 47-32 edge at Oklahoma City (11/4) ... On the season they've outpointed opponents by a combined score of 186-149.

* Al Horford has hit better than 50% from the floor in all five games this season, and is hitting .567 on the year, good for 10th in the NBA.

* Rookies John Jenkins and Mike Scott both made their NBA debuts on 11/11 @LAC ... Jenkins finished with six points and two rebounds in four minutes (2-4 FGs, 2-2 FTs), while Scott grabbed one rebound in four minutes (0-2 FGs).

* Atlanta native Lou Williams had a memorable debut for the Hawks, scoring 22 points, while adding five assists, four rebounds and three steals in 31 minutes off the bench vs. Houston (11/2) ... Williams' 22 points is the second-highest total for a player coming off the bench in his Hawks debut since the team moved to Atlanta (1968-69) ... Tom Van Arsdale's 23-point effort vs. Portland in 1974-75 is first on the list, while Larry Robinson is the only other player to top the 20-point mark (21) against Charlotte in 2000-01.

* Josh Smith is one of the top active shot blockers in the NBA ... For his career, Smith has recorded 1312 blocks while averaging 2.17 bpg ... He ranks tied for third among active players in bpg and 13th in total rejections (47th all-time).

* Several Hawks rank among league leaders – Josh Smith is t15th in blocks per game (2.00), Al Horford ranks t24th in rebounding (8.4), 10th in field goal percentage (.567) and t32nd in blocks per game (1.20), while Jeff Teague places t13th in assists (7.0), ninth in three-point percentage (.556) and t29th in steals per game (1.60) ... Zaza Pachulia is t38th in rebounds per game (7.6) and DeShawn Stevenson ranks t31st in three-point percentage (.450).

* Grammy Award-winning recording artist T.I. joined Bob Rathbun and former Hawk Duane Ferrell behind the microphone as a guest color commentator, calling the first half for SportSouth of the Hawks vs. Heat game at Philips Arena on 11/9.

November 15, 1996 – The Hawks set team records by holding Miami to 21 second half points and eight fourth quarter points during an 85-77 home win over the Heat.
