UPCOMING GAMES



Wednesday, Nov. 28, 2012 vs. Charlotte Bobcats (7:30 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM

Charlotte comes to Philips Arena for the first time this year in the second-of-four meetings with the Hawks ... Atlanta posted a 101-91 road win in game one (11/23) behind Al Horford's 26 points and 13 rebounds (career-high tying 13 FGM) ... Ramon Sessions paced Charlotte with 22 points ... The Hawks recorded a season-best 15 blocks in the game ... Atlanta hosts the Bobcats again on 12/13 and visits Charlotte on 1/23 to close out the season series ... The Hawks own a five-game winning streak in the series and have taken two-in-a-row at Philips Arena ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 17-16, including an 11-5 home mark.



Friday, Nov. 30, 2012 vs. Cleveland Cavaliers (7:30 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM

The Hawks host the Cavaliers for the first time this year in the first-of-four games between the clubs ... Atlanta visits Cleveland on 12/28 and 1/9, before playing the Cavs again at Philips Arena on 4/1 to finish the season series ... The Hawks own a seven-game winning streak against the Cavaliers, including four straight at Philips Arena ... Cleveland's last win over Atlanta was a 93-88 home decision on 4/2/10 and their last win at Philips Arena came on 12/29/09 (95-84) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 109-93 (65-34 at home).



Wednesday, Dec. 5, 2012 vs. Denver Nuggets (7:30 p.m.)

TV: No local broadcast ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM

The Nuggets visit Philips Arena for the only time this year in the first-of-two contests with the Hawks ... Atlanta travels to Denver on 3/4 to end the season series ... The Nuggets have a four-game win streak against the Hawks and took the last meeting at Philips Arena on 3/16/11 (102-87) ... Atlanta's last win in the series was a 125-100 home triumph on 11/7/09 ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 40-35, including a 29-7 home record.

COMMUNITY NEWS

* On 11/20, the entire Atlanta Hawks team, coaching staff, and several team executives served a Thanksgiving meal to 300 individuals at Clarkston Community Center.

NEWS & NOTES

* Atlanta's current five-game winning streak is the longest active win streak in the NBA, while the Hawks' 8-4 record is tied for the sixth best mark in the league (4-2 road record is tops in the Eastern Conference).

* Jeff Teague recorded 13 points and a season-high 12 assists at Charlotte on 11/23 and followed that up with 19 points and 11 assists the next night vs. the L.A. Clippers, marking the first time in the fourth-year point guard's career he's had back-to-back double doubles.

* The Hawks recorded 15 blocked shots at Charlotte on 11/23, the highest total in the NBA this year for a non-overtime game. Devin Harris and Lou Williams tied their career-highs with three blocks apiece, while Al Horford (three) and Kyle Korver (two) tied their season-bests. The last time Atlanta had 15 blocks was on 2/15/00 vs. New Jersey.

* Al Horford tied his career-high with 13 made FGs at Charlotte on 11/23, finishing the night with 26 points, 13 rebounds, three blocks and two assists.

* On 11/21 vs. Washington, Josh Smith posted his 182nd career double-double (25 points/12 rebounds) moving him past Dikembe Mutombo on the Hawks' all-time list. That same night, Smith jumped Bobby Jones for 46th in NBA/ABA history in career blocked shots. Smith has since tied Zydrunas Ilgauskas for 45th in league history with 1327 career rejections.

* Al Horford dished out a career-high 10 assists vs. Washington on 11/21, just missing his first career triple-double after also finishing the night with 15 points and nine rebounds.

* Kyle Korver recorded the 25th four-point play in Hawks history vs. Washington on 11/21 and became the 10th different Hawk to accomplish the feat.

* Last week Kyle Korver passed Hedo Turkoglu and tied Quentin Richardson for 42nd in NBA history with 1166 career 3FGs.

THIS WEEK IN HAWKS HISTORY

December 1, 1972 – The Hawks forced 40 Los Angeles turnovers, a franchise record for most turnovers by an opponent, in a 114-109 overtime road victory against the Lakers.
