### UPCOMING GAMES



**Monday, Dec. 10, 2012 at Miami Heat (7:30 p.m.)**  
**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM**

Atlanta visits Miami for the first time this year in the second-of-four games between the clubs ... The Heat posted a 95-89 win at Philips Arena (11/9) in the first meeting ... Chris Bosh led all scorers with 24 points and LeBron James tallied 21 points, 11 rebounds and nine assists ... Jeff Teague paced the Hawks with 20 points and 11 assists ... The teams play again on 2/20 (Philips Arena) and 3/12 (in Miami) to finish the season series ... The Heat currently own a four-game winning streak against Atlanta, including the last game in Miami on 3/7/12 (89-86) ... The Hawks' last win against the Heat was a 100-92 road decision on 1/2/12 ... Miami leads the all-time series 52-40, including a 33-13 home advantage.



**Wednesday, Dec. 12, 2012 at Orlando Magic (7 p.m.)**  
**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM**

The Hawks head to Orlando for the first time this year in the second-of-four contests with the Magic ... Atlanta recorded an 81-72 home triumph in Game 1, behind 15 points from Al Horford, while Glen Davis scored 11 for the Magic ... The Hawks visit Orlando again on 2/13 and host the Magic on 3/30 to close-out the season series ... Atlanta owns a seven-game winning streak against the Magic, including three straight in Orlando ... The Magic's last win in the series was a 93-89 home victory on 11/8/10 ... Orlando leads the all-time series 45-44, including a 30-15 edge at home.



**Thursday, Dec. 13, 2012 vs. Charlotte Bobcats (7:30 p.m.)**  
**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM**

Charlotte comes to Philips Arena for second-and-final time this year in third-of-four games with the Hawks ... Atlanta has taken the first two contests, a 101-91 road win on 11/23 and a 94-91 home decision on 11/28 ... Al Horford has two double-doubles, and is averaging 21.5 points and 12.0 rebounds in two games against the Bobcats this season, while Ramon Sessions is scoring at a 20.0 points per game clip against Atlanta ... The teams finish the season series on 1/23 in Charlotte ... The Hawks have a six-game win streak against the Bobcats, including three straight at Philips Arena ... Charlotte's last win against the Hawks was a 96-85 home triumph on 4/13/11, while their last victory at Philips Arena came on 2/12/11 (88-86) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 18-16 (12-5 at home).



**Saturday, Dec. 15, 2012 vs. Golden State Warriors (7 p.m.)**  
**TV: No local broadcast ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM**

The Warriors visit Philips Arena for the only time this year in the second-and-final meeting with the Hawks ... Golden State recorded a 92-88 home win in Game 1 behind double-doubles from Harrison Barnes (19 points/13 rebounds) and David Lee (18 points/10 boards) ... Lou Williams led the Hawks, who were playing without the services of Al Horford and Devin Harris (both out due to illness), with 18 points ... The Warriors have now won two consecutive games against Atlanta, including the last meeting at Philips Arena on 2/29/12 (85-82) ... The Hawks' last win in the series was a 95-79 decision on 2/25/11 and their last home win came on 12/29/10 (103-93) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 141-136, including an 83-40 home record.

### COMMUNITY NEWS

\* As part of the Season of Giving, the Hawks will host the "Hawks Holiday Hoopla" for 200 children from area non-profits for an evening of fun, games and food. The event will take place on 12/14 at Philips Arena beginning at 5:30 p.m. The entire team and coaching staff will participate in various activities, including arts and crafts, a basketball clinic, a photo station, face painting, gift giving and more. Participating organizations include CHRIS Kids, LaAmistad, My Sister's House and SafeHouse Outreach.

\* As part of his longtime commitment to the Make-A-Wish Foundation, Devin Harris presented a \$5,000 check to Make-A-Wish Georgia during halftime of the Hawks vs. Nuggets game on 12/5. Harris' 34 Ways to Assist Foundation was created with three primary initiatives in mind: The Make-A-Wish Foundation, Big Brothers Big Sisters, and healthy living through youth athletics and health and wellness.

### NEWS & NOTES

\* Atlanta has a three-game winning streak away from Philips Arena, improving their road record to 5-2 (.714), tops in the Eastern Conference and tied for third in the NBA.

\* Al Horford has recorded five consecutive double-doubles, averaging 18.0 points and 12.4 rebounds on .541 FG% during the streak, marking the fifth time in his career he's had five straight double-doubles.

\* Mike Scott is on assignment with Bakersfield in the NBA Development League and is averaging 10.7 points, 4.7 rebounds, 1.0 assists and 28.3 minutes (.464 FG%, .500 FT%) in three games.

\* Last week, Josh Smith passed Dominique Wilkins to move into third on Atlanta's all-time defensive rebounding list (currently 3590), while Al Horford jumped Cliff Levingston to move into ninth on the club's all-time blocked shots chart (currently 373).

\* In 616 career games, Josh Smith has averaged 15.1 points, 8.0 rebounds, 3.1 assists, 2.2 blocks and 1.3 steals. According to the Elias Sports Bureau, Smith is the only player in NBA history to boast career averages over 15.0 points, 7.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists, 2.0 blocks and 1.0 steals per game for his career.

\* In 333 career games, Al Horford has averaged 13.0 points, 9.5 rebounds and 1.1 blocks on .537 FG%, placing him alongside only Kareem Abdul-Jabbar, Shaquille O'Neal, Dwight Howard and Artis Gilmore with at least those averages (according to the Elias Sports Bureau).

### THIS WEEK IN HAWKS HISTORY

**December 10, 1986** – Dominique Wilkins ties his own franchise record (shared with Bob Pettit and Lou Hudson) by scoring 57 points (19 FGs, 19 FTs) in a 123-95 win over Chicago. Wilkins' 19 made free throws are tied for the fifth-highest single game total in club history.
