UPCOMING GAMES



Wednesday, Dec. 5, 2012 vs. Denver Nuggets (8 p.m.)

TV: ESPN ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM

The Nuggets visit Philips Arena for the only time this year in the first-of-two contests with the Hawks ... Atlanta travels to Denver on 3/4 to end the season series ... The Nuggets have a four-game win streak against the Hawks and took the last meeting at Philips Arena on 3/16/11 (102-87) ... Atlanta's last win in the series was a 125-100 home triumph on 11/7/09 ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 40-35, including a 29-7 home record.



Friday, Dec. 7, 2012 vs. Washington Wizards (7:30 p.m.)

TV: No local broadcast ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM

Atlanta hosts Washington for the second-and-final time in the second-of-four meetings between the clubs ... The Hawks posted a 101-100 overtime win in Game 1 (11/21) behind Josh Smith (25 points/12 rebounds) and Al Horford's (15 points/career-high 10 assists) double-doubles ... Kevin Seraphin paced the Wizards with 21 points and 10 boards, while Trevor Ariza had 12 points and 15 rebounds ... Atlanta visits the nation's capital on 12/18 and 1/12 to finish the season series ... The Hawks have a four-game winning streak against Washington and have taken nine straight at Philips Arena ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 142-133 (90-42 at home).



Saturday, Dec. 8, 2012 at Memphis Grizzlies (8 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM

The Hawks head to Memphis for the only time this year in the first-of-two games with the Grizzlies ... Memphis comes to Philips Arena on 2/6 to close out the season series ... The Grizzlies took the only meeting between the teams last year, a 96-77 decision at Philips Arena, on 2/2/12 ... Atlanta has won two straight road games against the Grizzlies, with their last loss coming on 4/15/09 (98-90) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 21-11, including an 8-7 road mark.

COMMUNITY NEWS

* Anthony Tolliver recently participated in an event at the W.W. Woolfolk Boys & Girls Club in Atlanta. The Hawks forward helped serve holiday meals before lending a hand with the kids for a talent and fashion show.

* As part of the NBA Cares Season of Giving, the NBA family continued the fight against HIV/AIDS in support of World AIDS Day on 12/1. Through a variety of partnerships, the league and its teams generated awareness and funds for HIV/AIDS education and research through special on-court apparel and in-arena activation. Additionally, Al Horford joined several NBA and WNBA players in a public service announcement in support of the initiative.

NEWS & NOTES

* Atlanta is the only team in the NBA to hold opponents to under .500 FG% in every game this season.

* The Hawks rank third in the NBA at 23.4 assists per game and have dished out at least 25 assists in each of the last five games (27.6 per game).

* On 12/1, the Hawks assigned guard John Jenkins and forward Mike Scott to the Bakersfield Jam, their NBA Development League affiliate.

* The Hawks-Nuggets game at Philips Arena on 12/5 will now tipoff at 8 p.m. and be broadcast on ESPN.

* Last week, Josh Smith moved into 45th place in NBA/ABA history in career blocked shots (currently 1335), while Kyle Korver jumped into 42nd all-time in career three-pointers made (currently 1168).

* Last week, Al Horford passed Steve Hawes to move into ninth on the Hawks' all-time defensive rebounds list (currently 2254), while Zaza Pachulia moved into ninth on the Hawks' all-time offensive rebounds list (currently 1154), passing Alan Henderson.

* Jeff Teague set a new career-high with six steals vs. Cleveland on 11/30, also finishing the night with 15 points and seven assists in 38 minutes.

* Al Horford was named NBA Eastern Conference Player of the Week for games played from 11/19-11/25. Horford led the Hawks to a perfect 4-0 week, averaging 16.5 points, 9.8 rebounds, 4.5 assists and 1.0 blocks in 35.5 minutes (.554 FG%).

* The Hawks-Nuggets game on 12/5 features the Aaron's Lucky Dog Wednesday's promotion, and includes an upper level ticket and \$10 food and beverage credit for \$25, while the Hawks-Wizards contest on 12/7 has the Hudson Grille 4 for Fridays promotion (four game tickets and four \$10 Hudson Grille gift cards starting at \$109).
