### UPCOMING GAMES



**Monday, Jan. 14, 2013 at Chicago Bulls (8 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD/NBA TV ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM**

Atlanta visits Chicago for the only time this year in the second-of-three contests against the Bulls ... The Hawks took the first meeting, a 92-75 home triumph on 12/22 behind 20 points and 10 rebounds from Al Horford ... Luol Deng's 11 points led Chicago ... The Bulls have taken the last three games against the Hawks in Chicago, with Atlanta's last win coming on 3/1/10 (116-92) ... The Hawks host the Bulls on 2/2 to closeout the season series ... Chicago leads the all-time series 116-102, including a 67-39 home mark.



**Wednesday, Jan. 16, 2013 vs. Brooklyn Nets (7:30 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM**

The Hawks host the Nets for the first time this year in the first-of-four games between the clubs ... Atlanta travels to Brooklyn on 1/18 and 3/17, while hosting the Nets again on 3/9 ... The Hawks currently own a five-game winning streak in the series and have won seven straight at Philips Arena ... Brooklyn's last win over Atlanta was an 89-82 home decision on 12/19/10 (in New Jersey), while their last victory at Philips Arena came on 11/15/08 (119-107) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 88-65, including a 56-20 advantage at home.



**Friday, Jan. 18, 2013 at Brooklyn Nets (7:30 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM**

Atlanta heads to Brooklyn for the first time in second-of-four tilts with the Nets ... The teams play again on 3/9 at Philips Arena and 3/17 in Brooklyn to finish the season series ... The Hawks currently own a five-game winning streak against the Nets, including the last two road games ... Brooklyn's last win against Atlanta was an 89-82 home decision on 12/19/10 (in New Jersey) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 88-65, with the Nets holding a 45-32 edge at home.



**Saturday, Jan. 19, 2013 vs. San Antonio Spurs (7 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM**

The Spurs come to Philips Arena for the only time this year in the first-of-two games against the Hawks ... Atlanta visits San Antonio on 4/6 to end the season series ... The Spurs have taken three straight games against the Hawks, including the last meeting at Philips Arena – 105-83 on 1/25/12 ... Atlanta's last win in the series was a 119-114 (OT) home triumph on 3/21/10 ... San Antonio leads the all-time series 43-36, with the Hawks holding a 24-15 advantage in home games.

### NEWS & NOTES

\* Kyle Korver has made at least one three-pointer in each of his last 30 games played, the longest streak of his career. Korver's run is also the second-longest in Hawks history behind Mookie Blaylock's 42 straight games (3/26/96-1/11/97).

\* Last week, Josh Smith passed Cliff Hagan to move into seventh place on the Hawks' all-time rebounds list (currently 5,053). Smith also moved up to 42<sup>nd</sup> in NBA/ABA history for career blocked shots (currently 1,384), passing Samuel Dalembert.

\* Hawks radio play-by-play announcer Steve Holman will call his 2,000<sup>th</sup> consecutive game (regular season and playoffs) when the Hawks play the Brooklyn Nets at Philips Arena on 1/16 (7:30 p.m. tipoff). Holman's streak, which is the longest active of any NBA announcer in radio or television, began in March of 1989.

\* Kyle Korver passed Dennis Scott to move into 41<sup>st</sup> place in NBA/ABA history for career three-pointers (currently 1,215) at Washington on 1/12.

\* The Hawks will host Hardwood Classics Nights for two upcoming games, and each evening features a number of special ceremonies and promotions honoring some of the best players and one of the most successful eras in team history. For both contests, the Hawks will don the classic red and black road jersey (created by adidas), worn by the club from 1995 to 1999. On 2/22, versus Sacramento (7:30 p.m. tip), the club will honor the all-90's team, recognizing the top player at each position as voted on at [www.hawks.com](http://www.hawks.com). The finalists for each starting position will be unveiled each week starting today. On 3/15, the club will host its second Hardwood Classic Night when Phoenix comes to town (7:30 p.m. start). Details of that night's festivities will be announced at a later date.

\* On 1/16, the Hawks are hosting Social Media Night at Philips Arena when the team takes on the Brooklyn Nets (7:30 p.m. tipoff). Participants will have access to a postgame Q&A session with Kyle Korver and more. Visit [www.hawks.com](http://www.hawks.com) for complete details.

### THIS WEEK IN HAWKS HISTORY

**January 16, 1972** – Pete Maravich scores 50 points in Atlanta's 124-116 home win over Philadelphia. It is tied for the ninth-highest scoring game in Hawks history. Exactly one year later, Maravich put his name in the record books again by dishing out 18 assists in Atlanta's 130-129 home win over Detroit in overtime. It is tied for the fifth-highest assist total in club history.
