### UPCOMING GAMES



**Wednesday, Feb. 20, 2013 vs. Miami Heat (8 p.m.)**  
**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM**

The Heat come to Philips Arena for the second-and-final time this year in the third-of-four showdowns with the Hawks ... Miami owns a 2-0 record against Atlanta so far, winning 95-86 at Philips Arena (11/9) and posting a 101-92 home decision on 12/10 ... Josh Smith is averaging 17.5 points in two games vs. Miami this year, while Jeff Teague is putting up 15.5 points and 7.0 assists (.556 FG%, .600 3FG%, 1.000 FT%), Al Horford 15.0 points (.565 FG%) and Anthony Morrow is chipping-in 11.5 points (.600 FG%, .667 3FG%, 1.000 FT%) ... LeBron James is averaging 24.0 points against the Hawks ... The teams play again on 3/12 in Miami to finish the season series ... The Heat currently own a five-game winning streak in the series and have taken six straight at Philips Arena ... The Hawks' last win was a 100-92 road triumph on 1/2/12, while their last home win came on 11/18/09 (105-90) ... The Heat lead the all-time series 53-40 with Atlanta holding a 27-19 edge at home.



**Friday, Feb. 22, 2013 vs. Sacramento Kings (7:30 p.m.)**  
**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM**

The Kings come to Philips Arena for the only time this year in the second-and-final showdown with the Hawks ... Atlanta posted a 112-96 triumph on 11/16 in the first meeting ... Kyle Korver (22), Lou Williams (21) and Al Horford (20 and 10 rebounds) all scored 20-plus points that night, while Jason Thompson put in 19 to pace Sacramento ... The Hawks currently own a nine-game winning streak in the series, including five straight at Philips Arena ... Sacramento's last win in the series was a 119-107 home decision on 2/20/08, with the last win at Philips Arena coming on 3/3/06 (102-93) ... The Kings lead the all-time series 152-151, with Atlanta holding an 83-29 edge in home games.



**Saturday, Feb. 23, 2013 at Milwaukee Bucks (8:30 p.m.)**  
**TV: SportSouth HD/NBA TV ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM**

Atlanta travels to Milwaukee for the first time this year in the first-of-four meetings between the clubs ... The teams play again on 3/20 (Philips Arena), 3/24 (Milwaukee) and 4/12 (Philips Arena) ... The Hawks took last season's series 2-1, splitting two games in Milwaukee, with the Bucks winning the final contest 108-101 on 3/27/12 ... The Bucks lead the all-time series 99-96, including a 62-32 advantage at home.

### NEWS & NOTES

\* Jeff Teague (Taco Bell Skills Challenge) and Dominique Wilkins (Sears Shooting Stars) both participated in Saturday night events at this year's All-Star Weekend in Houston on February 16 ... Wilkins (who was paired with Chris Bosh and Swin Cash) made two half-court shots, leading Team Bosh to the title in the event.

\* Josh Smith scored 26 points (10-15 FGs) and grabbed 13 rebounds, while teammate Al Horford recorded 21 points (10-14 FGs) and 10 boards at Dallas (2/11). According to the Elias Sports Bureau, it's the first time that two Atlanta teammates had 20 points, 10 rebounds, and made at least two-thirds of their shots from the floor in a non-overtime game since Hall-of-Famers Dominique Wilkins (37 points/12 rebounds, 16-24 FGs) and Moses Malone (29 points/11 boards, 13-17 FGs) did it at Golden State on 4/1/90

\* At Orlando (2/13), Josh Smith finished with 30 points, 10 rebounds and five assists, while Al Horford had 26 points, 12 boards and five assists. According to the Elias Sports Bureau, they are the first pair of Hawks teammates to each record at least 26 points, 10 rebounds and five assists in a game since Lenny Wilkens (30 points, 12 rebounds, 13 assists) and Joe Caldwell (30, 13, 6) on 11/24/67.

\* Larry Drew passed Harry Gallatin for eighth on the Hawks' all-time wins list (currently 113) with a 105-101 triumph at Dallas on 2/11.

\* The Hawks are hosting a Hardwood Classics Night on 2/22 vs. Sacramento. As part of the festivities the club will honor the all-1990's team, recognizing the top player at each position as voted on at [www.hawks.com](http://www.hawks.com). The Hawks will wear the classic red and black road jersey (created by adidas), worn by the club from 1995-to-1999. The team posted a 183-113 mark (.618) from 1995-'99, and a 406-300 record (.575) from 1990-'99, earning postseason trips eight times in nine seasons. Also, Hawks merchandise from that era will be available in the Team Gear store at Philips Arena.
