UPCOMING GAMES



Tuesday, Feb. 5, 2013 at Indiana Pacers (7 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM

Atlanta heads to Indiana for the first time this year in the third-of-four matchups between the clubs ... The Hawks have taken the first two games – on 11/7 (89-86) and 12/29 (109-100) ... The Pacers host Atlanta again on 3/25 to finish the season series ... Al Horford is averaging 18.0 points against the Pacers this year and Zaza Pachulia is putting up 11.5 points and 14.0 rebounds, grabbing 14 boards in both contests ... David West is averaging 24.5 points against Atlanta this season, topping 20 points in both games ... The Hawks have won four straight against the Pacers overall, including the last meeting in Indiana on 3/6/12 (101-96) ... The Pacers' last win in the series was a 96-84 home triumph on 1/11/12 ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 92-75 (33-50 on the road).



Wednesday, Feb. 6, 2013 vs. Memphis Grizzlies (7:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM

The Grizzlies come to Philips Arena for the only time this year in the second-and-final contest with the Hawks ... Atlanta posted a 93-83 road win in the first meeting (12/8) behind 24 points from Josh Smith, Lou Williams' 21 points and Al Horford's double-double (19 points/14 rebounds) ... Zach Randolph's 18 points and 13 boards paced Memphis ... The Grizzlies won the last game between the clubs at Philips Arena, a 96-77 triumph on 2/2/12 ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 22-11, including a 13-4 advantage at home.



Friday, Feb. 8, 2013 vs. New Orleans Hornets (7:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM

The Hawks host the Hornets for the only time this year in the second-and-final game between the teams ... Atlanta notched a 95-86 road victory in the first meeting (1/1) as Josh Smith (23 points/13 rebounds) and Zaza Pachulia (12 points/10 boards) recorded double-doubles, and Al Horford scored 20 points ... Ryan Anderson put in 23 points for New Orleans and Greivis Vasquez had 17 points and 10 assists ... Atlanta has now won two straight overall against the Hornets, but dropped the last meeting at Philips Arena (94-72) on 1/29/12 ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 43-38, including a 25-16 home mark.

NEWS & NOTES

* Atlanta signed Jannero Pargo to a second 10-day contract on 2/2. Pargo is averaging 4.3 points, 2.3 assists and 0.8 rebounds (15.7 minutes) in six games with the Hawks this season.

* The Hawks set a franchise record by connecting on 10-plus 3FGs in five consecutive games from 1/21-1/30 ... Prior to this season, Atlanta had made 10-plus in three straight games twice previously (April of 1997 and November of 1995), but have had streaks this year of five, four and three games ... The Hawks have hit double-digit three's 17 times overall this year, second-best in franchise history (21 in 1996-97).

* Kyle Korver needs two 3FGs to tie Clifford Robinson (33rd with 1253) and five to equal Vernon Maxwell (32nd with 1256) on the NBA's all-time 3FGM list ... Korver currently leads the NBA in three-point percentage (.474) and is fourth in makes (117).

* Josh Smith is averaging 21.2 points (106) on .511 FG% (47-92) over the last five games, scoring 20-plus points three times ... Al Horford is averaging 20.8 points (104) on .579 FG% (44-76) in his last five games played, scoring 20-plus points three times.

* The Hawks-Grizzlies game on 2/6 features the Aaron's Lucky Dog Wednesday's promotion, and includes an upper level ticket and \$10 food and beverage credit for \$25, while the Hawks-Hornets contest on 2/8 has the Hudson Grille 4 for Fridays promotion (four game tickets and four \$10 Hudson Grille gift cards starting at \$109). February 5, 1972 – Pete Maravich scores 50 points in Atlanta's 120-117 home win over Cleveland. It is tied for the ninth-highest single game scoring effort in franchise history. Maravich's 20 made field goals (20-27) are tied for sixth on the club's all-time list.
