UPCOMING GAMES



Tuesday, Mar. 12, 2013 at Miami Heat (7:30 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD/NBA TV ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM

Atlanta visits Miami for the second time in the fourth-and-final meeting between the teams ... The Heat own a 3-0 record in this year's series, including the last game in Miami (101-92) on 12/10 ... Miami also posted wins of 95-89 (11/9) and 103-90 (2/20) at Philips Arena ... Al Horford is averaging 19.0 points versus the Heat this year, while LeBron James is putting up 25.0 points against the Hawks (with two double-doubles) ... Miami currently owns a six-game winning streak in the series, including two straight at home ... Atlanta's last win over the Heat was 100-92 road decision on 1/2/12 ... The Heat lead the all-time series 54-40, including a 34-13 home record.



Wednesday, Mar. 13, 2013 vs. Los Angeles Lakers (7:30 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM

The Lakers come to Philips Arena for the only time this year in the second-and-final showdown with the Hawks ... Los Angeles recorded a 99-98 home triumph in the first meeting on Kobe Bryant's bucket with under 10 seconds to play ... Bryant finished the night with 34 points, while Dwight Howard (11 points/15 rebounds) and Steve Nash (15 points/10 assists) notched double-doubles ... Al Horford led the Hawks with 24 points and Josh Smith scored 19 ... L.A. currently owns a four-game win streak in the series, including the last meeting at Philips Arena (101-87) on 3/8/11 ... Atlanta's last win against the Lakers was a 109-92 home triumph on 3/31/10 ... The Lakers lead the all-time series 182-134, including a 30-27 road mark (since the Hawks moved to Atlanta).



Friday, Mar. 15, 2013 vs. Phoenix Suns (7:30 p.m.)

Phoenix visits Philips Arena for the only time this year in the second-and-final contest with the Hawks ... The Suns posted a 92-87 home win in the first meeting on 3/1 ... Al Horford scored 20 points to pace Atlanta, while Goran Dragic had 19 points for Phoenix ... The Suns have taken the last two games at Philips Arena, with Atlanta's last home win coming on 1/15/10 (102-101) ... Phoenix leads the all-time series 67-48, with the Hawks holding a 29-25 advantage in home games.



Sunday, Mar. 17, 2013 at Brooklyn Nets (8 p.m.)

The Hawks head to Brooklyn for the second time in the fourth-and-final game with the Nets ... The Nets have taken two-of-three contests against Atlanta this year, including the last two ... The Hawks posted a 109-95 home triumph on 1/16 before Brooklyn notched a 94-89 home win on 1/18 and a 93-80 decision at Philips Arena on 3/9 ... Jeff Teague has recorded two 20 point/10 assist outings in three games against the Nets, while Al Horford has tallied two point/rebound double-doubles in two games played ... Brook Lopez is averaging 20.0 points in the three games versus Atlanta ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 89-67, with the Nets holding a 46-32 edge in home games.

NEWS & NOTES

* Josh Smith scored his 10,000th career point at Denver on 3/4, in the process becoming the 24th player in NBA history with 10,000 points, 5000 rebounds, 2000 assists and 1000 blocked shots. He is the ninth player to compile those numbers with one team, joining Hakeem Olajuwon, David Robinson, Patrick Ewing, Karl Malone, Julius Erving, Tim Duncan, Dirk Nowitzki and Kevin Garnett. For his career, Smith has 10,063 points, 5,273 rebounds, 2,101 assists and 1,418 blocked shots.

* Kyle Korver extended his consecutive games streak with at least one three-pointer made to 55 vs. Brooklyn on 3/9. That same night he tied former Hawk Mookie Blaylock for 31st in NBA history with his 1,283rd three-pointer.

* Last week, Al Horford moved past Jon Koncak into seventh place on Hawks' all-time defensive rebounding list (currently 2,604).

* Jeff Teague dished out his 1,000th career assist vs. Philadelphia on 3/6.

* Anthony Tolliver hit a career-best five three-pointers vs. Philadelphia on 3/6, finishing the night with season-highs of 21 points and eight rebounds, to go along with two blocks and one assist in 27 minutes (7-10 FGs, 5-7 3FGs, 2-2 FTs).

* Rookie Mike Scott was recalled from the Bakersfield Jam of the NBA Development League on 3/6. Scott was assigned on 3/1 and started three games for the Jam, averaging 24.7 points, 11.3 rebounds and 1.7 assists in 37.3 minutes (.482 FG%, .909 FT%), recording at least 20 points and 10 rebounds in each contest.

* Atlanta waived forward/center Jeremy Tyler on 3/6. Acquired from Golden State on 2/21, Tyler appeared in one game for the Hawks, grabbing three rebounds in five minutes of action.

* The Hawks signed Shelvin Mack to a 10-day contract on 3/6. In his second NBA season, Mack had played in 11 total games (two starts) with Washington and Philadelphia, averaging 3.6 points on .401 shooting, 1.5 rebounds and 2.2 assists in 13.7 minutes per game. The 6-foot-3, 215-pound point guard from Butler most recently played with the Maine Red Claws of the NBA Development League. In 23 games (22 starts), he averaged 20.1 points on .454 shooting, 4.3 rebounds and 7.7 assists in 40.3 minutes per game and was selected to participate in the 2013 NBA Development League All-Star Game.

* The Hawks are hosting the second-and-final Hardwood Classics Night of the season on 3/15 vs. Phoenix. Atlanta will don the classic red and black road jersey (created by adidas), worn by the club from 1995-to-1999. The team posted a 183-113 mark (.618) from 1995-'99, and a 406-300 record (.575) from 1990-'99, earning postseason trips eight times in nine seasons. The contest also features the Hudson Grille 4 for Fridays promotion (four game tickets and four \$10 Hudson Grille gift cards starting at \$109). Visit www.hawks.com for more information.

THIS WEEK IN HAWKS HISTORY

March 14, 1997 – Steve Smith sets a franchise record by hitting nine three-pointers in a 97-91 home loss to Seattle. He finished the night with 36 points on 10-20 FGs, 9-15 3FGs and 7-7 FTs. Smith also set a record for three's in a quarter (7) which was later tied by Henry James.
