UPCOMING GAMES



Monday, Mar. 18, 2013 vs. Dallas Mavericks (7:30 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM

The Mavericks visit Philips Arena for the only time this year in the second-and-final meeting with the Hawks ... Atlanta recorded a 105-101 road victory in the first game (2/11) behind three players with 20-plus points – Josh Smith (26 points/13 rebounds), Al Horford (21 points/10 boards) and Jeff Teague (20 points/nine assists) ... Dirk Nowitzki paced Dallas with 24 points ... The Hawks have now won two straight against the Mavs overall, including the last contest at Philips Arena on 4/26/12 (106-89) ... Dallas' last win in the series was a 102-91 home decision on 1/29/11 while their last at Philips Arena came on 11/20/10 (98-93) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 33-30, including an 18-13 home mark.



Wednesday, Mar. 20, 2013 vs. Milwaukee Bucks (7:30 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM

Milwaukee comes to Philips Arena for the first time this year in the second-of-four contests with the Hawks ... Atlanta posted a 103-102 road win in the first meeting on Al Horford's bucket with under six seconds to play ... Horford (23 points/11 rebounds) and Josh Smith (15 points/13 boards) each notched a double-double that night and Jeff Teague tallied 23 points and nine assists ... Ersan Ilyasova led six Bucks in double-figures with 19 points, while Larry Sanders (12 points/19 boards) and Monta Ellis (14 points/10 assists) had double-doubles ... The teams play again on 3/24 at Milwaukee and 4/12 at Philips Arena to finish the season series ... The Hawks have won two straight home games against the Bucks, with Milwaukee's last win at Philips Arena coming on 11/10/10 (108-92) ... The Bucks lead the all-time series 99-97, with Atlanta holding a 63-35 advantage in home games.



Friday, Mar. 22, 2013 vs. Portland Trail Blazers (7:30 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM

The Hawks host the Trail Blazers for the only time this year in the second-and-final showdown between the clubs ... Atlanta took the first meeting on 11/12 (95-87) behind double-doubles from Josh Smith (19 points/11 rebounds) and Al Horford (15 points/10 boards) ... J.J. Hickson tallied 19 points and 18 rebounds for Portland ... The Hawks have won four straight home games against the Blazers, with Portland's last win at Philips Arena coming on 1/21/08 (111-109 OT) ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 51-50, including a 33-16 edge at home.



Sunday, Mar. 24, 2013 at Milwaukee Bucks (3 p.m.)

Atlanta heads to Milwaukee for the second time in the third-of-four tilts with the Bucks ... Atlanta posted a 103-102 road win in the first meeting on Al Horford's bucket with under six seconds to play ... Horford (23 points/11 rebounds) and Josh Smith (15 points/13 boards) each notched a double-double that night and Jeff Teague tallied 23 points and nine assists ... Ersan Ilyasova led six Bucks in double-figures with 19 points, while Larry Sanders (12 points/19 boards) and Monta Ellis (14 points/10 assists) had double-doubles ... The teams will have also met up on 3/20 and will closeout the season series on 4/12 at Philips Arena ... Milwaukee leads the all-time series 99-97 (62-33 at home).

* In partnership with United Way of Greater Atlanta, the Hawks launched BE GREATER ATLANTA to recognize individuals that are making a difference in their communities. The organization will honor Kate Atwood on 3/18 vs. Dallas and Lisa Patton on 3/22 vs. Portland (the honoree for 3/20 vs. Milwaukee is TBA).

NEWS & NOTES

* On 3/16, Atlanta inked guard Shelvin Mack to a second 10-day contract. Mack signed his first 10-day deal with the Hawks on 3/6 and is averaging 1.3 points in 5.2 minutes in six games with the club.

* Last week, Kyle Korver moved past former Hawk Mookie Blaylock into 31st place in NBA history with 1,292 three-pointers. Korver has connected on at least one three-pointer in 59 consecutive games, the longest streak in the NBA since Peja Stojakovic's run of 62 games from 1/16/08-12/10/08.

* Jeff Teague tallied 11 points, a career-high tying 15 assists, five rebounds, two steals and two blocks in 37 minutes at Brooklyn on 3/17. He is the first Hawk to dish out 15 assists in a reserve role since Spud Webb turned the trick on 12/4/87, also against the Nets.

* Devin Harris hit his 2500th career field goal vs. L.A. Lakers on 3/13, while Al Horford grabbed his 1000th career offensive rebound vs. Phoenix on 3/15.

* Last week, Al Horford tied Kevin Willis (eighth with 425) on the Hawks' all-time blocked shot chart. Horford is 11 rejections behind Theo Ratliff for seventh place on the list.

* Al Horford has scored in double-figures in 25 consecutive games, the second longest streak of his career behind a 33 game stretch in 2009-10.

* Jeff Teague has hit 44-of-his-last-45 (.978) from the free throw line over his last 15 games played, including 23-in-a-row (last miss at Utah on 2/27). On the season, he ranks sixth in the NBA in FT% at .894.

* Johan Petro made his second career three-pointer vs. Phoenix on 3/15, finishing the night with five points, two rebounds, two assists and one block in nine minutes.

* Atlanta ranks third in the NBA in fast break points at 17.4 per game.

* The Hawks-Bucks game on 3/20 features the Aaron's Lucky Dog Wednesday's promotion, and includes an upper level ticket and \$10 food and beverage credit for \$25, while the Hawks-Trail Blazers contest on 3/22 has the Hudson Grille 4 for Fridays promotion (four game tickets and four \$10 Hudson Grille gift cards starting at \$109).
