UPCOMING GAMES



Tuesday, Apr. 16, 2013 vs. Toronto Raptors (7:30 p.m.)
TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 680 AM/93.7 FM

Toronto visits Philips Arena for the second time in the third-and-final meeting with the Hawks ... Atlanta sports a 2-0 record in the season series, posting a 93-92 home win on 1/30 and 107-88 road triumph on 3/27 ... Al Horford (22 points/10 rebounds) and Josh Smith (20 points/11 boards) recorded double-doubles in the first game, while DeMar DeRozan scored 23 points and Kyle Lowry (14 points/10 rebounds) had a double-double ... Horford tallied 26 points and 12 boards in the second contest and Jeff Teague added 24 points and 13 assists ... Jonas Valanciunas led the Raptors with 19 and Rudy Gay had 15 points and 12 rebounds ... The Hawks have won three straight overall against the Raptors, including the last meeting at Philips Arena (1/30/13) ... Toronto's last win in the series came on 4/15/12 in Atlanta (102-86) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 39-27, including a 20-13 home mark.



Wednesday, Apr. 17, 2013 at New York Knicks (8:00 p.m.)

Atlanta closes the regular season with a visit to New York in the third-of-three contests with the Knicks ... The Knicks have won the first two matchups between the teams this season, nipping Atlanta 106-104 in New York on 1/27 and defeating the Hawks 95-82 in Atlanta on 4/3 ... Jeff Teague is averaging 21.0 points and 7.5 assists on .560 FG% versus New York this season, while Kyle Korver is putting up 19.0 points and 6.5 rebounds on .545 FG% and .500 3FG% ... The Knicks currently own a three-game winning streak in the series and have also taken three-in-a-row in New York ... Atlanta's last win was a 100-90 home triumph on 3/30/12, with their last road win coming on 11/27/10 (99-90) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 184-167, but have a 59-87 record at New York.

COMMUNITY NEWS

* Devin Harris is the recipient of this year's Jason Collier Memorial Trophy, awarded annually to the individual who best exemplifies the characteristics Collier displayed off the court as a community ambassador.

NEWS & NOTES

* The Hawks have clinched a postseason berth for the sixth consecutive season, tied with Boston for the longest active playoff streak in the Eastern Conference. Atlanta is currently the fifth seed in the East.

* Kyle Korver's 186 3FGM currently rank fourth on the Hawks' all-time single season list, trailing Mookie Blaylock (199 in 1994-95) for third. Jeff Teague's 570 assists are currently eighth on Atlanta's single season chart, and his .881 FT% is fourth, behind Tom McMillen (.891 in 1978-79), Jason Terry (.887 in 2002-03) and Tyronn Lue (.883 in 2006-07). Al Horford's 562 defensive rebounds rank 10th on the Hawks' all-time single season chart (Horford is also ninth on the list with 563 in 2009-10), trailing Moses Malone (570 in 1988-89) for eighth.

* On 4/10 at Philadelphia, the Hawks put up their highest point total in a non-overtime game this season, beating the 76ers 124-101.

* With 10 20-point/10-assist games on the season, Jeff Teague is amongst the club's all-time single season leaders in that category. Only two other players in Atlanta history have recorded 10-or-more in a season – Pete Maravich with 12 in 1972-73, and Eddie Johnson with 11 in 1984-85. Teague has 15 total point/assist double-doubles on the year.

* On 4/12 against the Bucks, Kyle Korver extended his streak of games with at least one three-pointer made to 72 contests (the fourth-longest in NBA history).

* On 4/10 at Philadelphia, forward Josh Smith passed Joe Johnson for seventh place on the Hawks' all-time field goals made list. Smith enters the week with 4,028 FGM for his career.

* On 4/10 at Philadelphia, Al Horford recorded the 1000th assist of his career.

* On 4/10 at Philadelphia, guard John Jenkins (21 points) became the first Atlanta rookie to score at least 20 points in consecutive games since Josh Childress accomplished the feat in 2005.

* On 4/8, former Hawks player and coach Richie Guerin was announced as a member of the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame's 2013 class.

THIS WEEK IN HAWKS HISTORY

April 19, 1986 – Hall-of-Famer Dominique Wilkins ties Bob Pettit's playoff franchise record by scoring 50 points in a 137-125 win over Detroit. The Hawks would go on to win the first round series 3-1 before falling to Boston in the Eastern Conference Semifinals.
