SERIES RECAP

Indiana posted 107-90 and 113-98 home wins to open the series before Atlanta took Game 3, 90-69 at Philips Arena on 4/27 ... Game 4 is tonight at Philips Arena and Game 5 will be Wednesday at Bankers Life Fieldhouse ... Al Horford is averaging 17.7 points and 10.7 rebounds on .558 FG% in the series, including career-highs of 26 points, 16 rebounds and 12 FGM in Game 3 ... Jeff Teague is averaging 16.7 points (also 5.7 assists), Josh Smith 15.0 (also .526 FG%) and Devin Harris 11.0 ... Paul George is leading the Pacers with 22.0 points, 9.3 rebounds and 5.3 assists, recording a triple-double (23 points, 12 assists, 11 rebounds) in Game 1 ... George Hill is putting up 14.3 points, Roy Hibbert 13.0, David West 12.7 and Gerald Green 12.0 ... After the win in Game 3, the Hawks have won 12 consecutive games against the Pacers at Philips Arena (regular season and postseason combined) ... Indiana's last win in Atlanta came on 12/22/06.

ALL-TIME REGULAR SEASON/POSTSEASON

Atlanta and Indiana square off in a first round playoff series after splitting four games in the regular season ... The Hawks took the first two contests (both at Philips Arena) before dropping the last two at Indiana ... The Hawks have won 11 consecutive regular season home games in the series, with the Pacers' last win coming on 12/22/06 (100-90) ... Atlanta leads the all-time regular season series 92-77 (58-25 at home, 33-52 on the road, 1-0 on neutral court) ... Jeff Teague (5.3 assists) and Al Horford (7.8 rebounds) each averaged 16.0 points in the four games between the clubs this year ... David West tallied 21.3 points against the Hawks, seeing action in three-of-the-four contest ... This will mark the fifth time Atlanta and Indiana have met in the postseason (previously three times in the first round and once in the Eastern Conference Quarterfinals) ... The Hawks have taken two-of-the-three first round series', winning 3-1 in 1987 and 3-2 in 1996, while falling in 1995 (3-0) ... The Pacers posted 4-2 quarterfinals series triumph in 1994 ... The Hawks are 8-11 all-time against the Pacers in the postseason (5-3 at home and 3-8 on the road) ... Indiana won the last postseason meeting in Atlanta on 5/2/96 (83-75).

NEWS & NOTES

* In Game 3 (4/27), Atlanta held Indiana to .272 FG% (22-81), the lowest opponent FG% and fewest FGM allowed in Hawks' postseason history. The Pacers' 69 points that night is tied for the third fewest by an opponent in Hawks playoff history and their 30 first half points was also an all-time opponent low. The Pacers' .272 FG% is the lowest in postseason play since Boston held Indiana to .269 shooting (21-78) on 4/30/05.

* For the third straight year Jeff Teague has increased his scoring average in the playoffs from the regular season. The fourth-year guard is scoring at a 16.7 points per game clip through the first three postseason games after averaging 14.6 points in the regular season. Last year, Teague put up 14.0 ppg in the playoffs, up from 12.6 in the regular season, and in 2010-11 he tallied 11.8 ppg in the playoffs (5.2 in the regular season).

* Josh Smith and Al Horford are climbing the all-time Atlanta playoff leader boards in a number of categories. Smith is currently tied with Kevin Willis for fourth in games played (49), fourth in points (763, third in rebounds (416), fifth in assists (146) and fifth in FGM (287). Horford ranks seventh in games played (45), fourth in rebounds (396) and eighth in assists (122).

* Several Hawks have set or tied single-game postseason career-highs in the First Round Playoff Series with Indiana: Devin Harris – 40 minutes played; Al Horford – 26 points, 16 rebounds, 12 FGM; Ivan Johnson – 27 minutes played, 10 points, seven rebounds, two steals and five FGM; Johan Petro – six points and three FGM; Josh Smith – three steals; DeShawn Stevenson – five rebounds; Jeff Teague – six rebounds, seven assists and two 3FGM.

* Veterans Anthony Tolliver and Shelvin Mack have joined rookies John Jenkins and Mike Scott in making their postseason debuts in the First Round Playoff Series with Indiana.

* Injury Report: Zaza Pachulia (sore right Achilles) and Lou Williams (torn ACL, right knee) are both out.
