Thursday, Oct. 17, 2013 vs. San Antonio Spurs (7:30 p.m.)

Atlanta hosts San Antonio for the only game between the clubs in the preseason ... The teams will play twice during the 2013-14 regular season – at San Antonio on 12/2 and at Philips Arena on 1/24 ... The Spurs swept the 2012-13 season series 2-0 ... San Antonio currently owns a five-game regular season winning streak against the Hawks, including the last two contests in Atlanta ... The Hawks last defeated the Spurs on 3/21/10 in a 119-114 overtime triumph at Philips Arena ... The Spurs lead the all-time series 45-36, but the Hawks hold a 24-16 edge at home.

Atlanta owns a two-game regular season winning streak against Memphis, including the last meeting at Philips Arena ... The Grizzlies last defeated the Hawks 96-77 on 2/2/12 at Philips Arena ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 23-11, including a 14-4 home record.

* The Hawks' "Paint The Town" event is scheduled for Friday, 10/18. Hawks players, coaches, cheerleaders and mascots will attend two high school football games: Alpharetta High School at Chattahoochee High School (7:30 p.m. kickoff) and Stephenson High School vs. Miller Grove High School at Halford Stadium in Clarkston, GA (8:00 p.m. kickoff).

NEWS & NOTES

* Hawks forward Mike Scott posted a team-high in points in each of the first two games of the preseason. On 10/7, Scott scored 13 points (6-10 FGs, 1-1 FTs) in 21 minutes at Miami. The following night, Scott tallied a game-high 19 points (8-11 FGs, 2-3 3FGs, 1-1 FTs) in 28 minutes versus the Charlotte Bobcats in Asheville, NC.

* On 10/8, Hawks rookie guard Dennis Schröder hit the game-winning floater with 2.1 seconds remaining to lift Atlanta to its first preseason victory, an 87-85 win over Charlotte. Schröder finished with nine points and a game-high seven assists.

* Through three preseason games, Al Horford leads the Hawks in scoring (15.5 ppg), and rebounding (7.5 rpg). Other Hawks leaders include: Dennis Schröder (4.7 apg), Elton Brand (3.5 bpg) and Royal Ivey and Jeff Teague (2.0 spg).

* Atlanta Hawks individual game tickets for the 2013-14 preseason and regular season games through 1/10/14 are now on sale to the general public. Games including the New York Knicks, Los Angeles Clippers, Oklahoma City Thunder and Los Angeles Lakers are available for purchase with no ticketing fees by visiting www.hawks.com, by calling (866) 715-1500, and at the Philips Arena Box Office or any Ticketmaster outlet.

* SportSouth will televise 75 Atlanta Hawks games throughout the 2013-14 NBA season, all in high definition. Hall of Famer Dominique Wilkins returns for his sixth season as the Hawks game analyst with play-by-play announcer Bob Rathbun, entering his 18th season as the Voice of the Hawks.

* Gustavo Ayon (right shoulder injury), John Jenkins (low back spasms) and Lou Williams (left knee rehabilitation) did not play against Charlotte or New Orleans. Ayon suffered the injury on 10/7 at Miami and his expected recovery time is approximately 4-8 weeks. Williams is listed as out versus San Antonio on 10/17 while Jenkins is day-to-day.
