### UPCOMING GAMES



**Wednesday, Oct. 30, 2013 at Dallas Mavericks (8:30 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

The Hawks travel to Dallas to open the regular season in a rematch of each team's final preseason matchup ... The clubs will meet once more during 2013-14 regular season at Philips Arena on 11/29 ... The 2012-13 season series resulted in a 1-1 split with each team winning on the road ... Dallas took the last contest 127-113 on 3/18/13 in Atlanta, with the last Hawks victory coming on 2/11/13 in a 105-101 triumph in Dallas ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 33-31 (15-17 on the road).



**Friday, Nov. 1, 2013 vs. Toronto Raptors (7:30 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

Atlanta welcomes Toronto to Philips Arena for the first of four matchups between the teams ... The clubs will play again in Atlanta on 3/18 and at Toronto on 2/12 and 3/23 ... The Hawks won the 2012-13 season series 2-1, splitting both contests at Philips Arena and taking the only game in Toronto ... The Raptors won the last contest 113-96 in Atlanta on 4/16/13 ... The last Hawks home victory was a 93-92 contest on 1/30/13 ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 39-28, including an 20-14 home record.



**Sunday, Nov. 3, 2013 at Los Angeles Lakers (9:30 p.m.)**

**TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: 92.9 FM**

The Hawks begin a three-game road trip with a matchup against the Lakers at STAPLES Center ... The clubs will close out the two-game season series at Philips Arena on 12/16 ... The teams split the 2012-13 season series 1-1, with both teams winning at home ... The Hawks won the last meeting, a 96-92 home contest on 3/13/13 ... The Lakers own a seven-game home winning streak against the Hawks ... Atlanta's last road victory was a 114-110 triumph on 2/15/06 ... The Lakers lead the all-time series 182-135, including a 43-16 home record since the Hawks moved to Atlanta in 1968-69.

### COMMUNITY NEWS

\* The Atlanta Hawks Foundation sells 50/50 raffle tickets at every Hawks home game. Net proceeds from the raffle sales each game will be split equally between the winner and the Atlanta Hawks Foundation.

\* On 10/26, the entire Atlanta Hawks team and coaching staff hosted a free clinic for 60 children at Wade Walker Park Family YMCA in Stone Mountain. As part of NBA Cares Week (10/20-10/27), the Hawks taught the game of basketball through drills, skills and friendly competition with a focus on the benefits of health and wellness.

### NEWS & NOTES

\* John Jenkins (low back spasms) played in the final two preseason contests after missing the first five. He averaged 4.5 points, 3.5 assists and 1.5 assists in 21 minutes.

\* Dennis Schröder made his first start in the Hawks' preseason-finale, a 98-88 loss at Dallas on 10/23. Schröder tallied a game-high 21 points (8-12 FGs, 1-2 3FGs, 4-6 FTs) and four assists in 36 minutes.

\* Last week Atlanta waived Eric Dawson (10/26) Royal Ivey (10/25) and James Johnson (10/21).

\* Hawks final preseason leaders: Al Horford (12.8 ppg, 7.6 rpg), Jeff Teague (5.5 apg), Elton Brand (1.8 bpg), Horford/Paul Millsap (1.4 spg), Mike Scott (.618 FG%).

\* Six Hawks averaged at least 10 points per game during the preseason: Al Horford (12.8), Paul Millsap (12.4), Mike Scott (12.0), Jeff Teague (11.5), DeMarre Carroll (11.4) and Kyle Korver (10.7).

\* Mike Scott was the only Hawk to see action in all seven preseason games. Scott averaged 12.0 points, 3.1 rebounds and shot a team-best .618 FG%. He shot .417 from beyond-the-arc and .846 from the free throw line.

\* The Hawks have four international players on the roster this year, including representatives from the Republic of Macedonia (Pero Antic, the first NBA player from the country), Gustavo Ayon (Mexico), Al Horford (Dominican Republic) and Dennis Schröder (Germany).

\* With a 104-95 triumph at Oklahoma City on 11/4/12, the Hawks won their third straight road opener, tying the franchise record set from 1986-88. Atlanta opens the 2013-14 regular season at Dallas on 10/30.

\* "On The Court With Coach Bud" premiered on 10/24 as Hawks Head Coach Mike Budenholzer joined SportsRadio 92.9 The Game (FM) for his first show. The weekly coach's show, hosted by Jason Goff, can be heard each Thursday during the season from 6-7 p.m. Additionally, Hawks President of Basketball Operations & General Manager Danny Ferry will be a weekly guest on the "The Rick & Jamie Show" on 92.9 The Game each Tuesday during the 11 o'clock hour.
