UPCOMING GAMES



Monday, Oct. 7, 2013 at Miami Heat (7:30 p.m.)

TV: NBA TV ... Radio: 92.9 FM

Atlanta travels to Miami for the only game between the clubs in the preseason ... The teams will play four times during the 2013-14 regular season – at Miami on 11/19 and 12/23, and at Philips Arena on 1/20 and 4/12 ... The Heat swept the 2012-13 season series 4-0 ... Miami currently owns a seven-game winning streak against the Hawks, including three straight at home ... Atlanta's most recent victory was a 100-92 triumph in Miami on 1/2/12 ... The Heat lead the all-time series 55-40, including a 35-13 mark at Miami.



Tuesday, Oct. 8, 2013 at Charlotte Bobcats (7:30 p.m.)

TV: SportSouth HD ... Radio: No local broadcast

The Hawks head to Asheville, NC for the only preseason match-up with the Bobcats ... The clubs will meet four times during the 2013-14 regular season – at Charlotte on 11/11 and 3/17, and at Philips Arena on 12/28 and 4/14 ... The Hawks swept the 2012-13 season series 4-0 and own an eight-game regular season winning streak against the Bobcats ... Charlotte's last victory over Atlanta was a 96-85 home win on 4/13/11 ... Atlanta leads the all-time series 20-16, but the Bobcats have an 11-7 edge at home.



Sunday, Oct. 13, 2013 at New Orleans Pelicans (2 p.m.)

TV: No local broadcast ... Radio: No local broadcast

Atlanta travels to Biloxi, MS for the only meeting against the Pelicans during the preseason ... The teams will match-up twice during the 2013-14 regular season – at New Orleans on 2/5 and at Philips Arena on 3/21 ... Atlanta and New Orleans split the 2012-13 season series 1-1, with the visiting team winning each contest ... Atlanta has won two straight regular season games at New Orleans, with New Orleans last recording a home victory on 12/26/10 (93-86) ... The Hawks lead the all-time series 43-39 (18-22 on the road).

Hawks players, coaches, cheerleaders and mascots will attend two high school football games: Alpharetta High School at Chattahoochee High School (7:30 p.m. kickoff) and Stephenson High School vs. Miller Grove High School at Halford Stadium in Clarkston (8:00 p.m. kickoff).

* On 9/27, the Atlanta Hawks Foundation dedicated the basketball court at James T. Anderson Boys & Girl Club in Marietta, Georgia. Kyle Korver, Dennis Schröder and Mike Scott were present along with Harry The Hawk and the Hawks Cheerleaders. The \$25,000 renovation was the latest for Atlanta Hawks Foundation Court Renovation program, presented by the Georgia National Guard.

* Atlanta Hawks individual game tickets for the 2013-14 preseason and regular season games through 1/10/14 are now on sale to the general public. Games including the New York Knicks (11/13), Los Angeles Clippers (12/4), Oklahoma City Thunder (12/10) and Los Angeles Lakers (12/16), are available for purchase with no ticketing fees by visiting www.hawks.com, by calling (866) 715-1500, and at the Philips Arena Box Office or any Ticketmaster outlet.

* SportSouth will televise 75 Atlanta Hawks games throughout the 2013-14 NBA season, all in high definition. Hall of Famer Dominique Wilkins returns for his sixth season as the Hawks game analyst with play-by-play announcer Bob Rathbun, entering his 18th season as the voice of the Hawks.

* On 7/1, CBS RADIO's SportsRadio 92.9 The Game became the official flagship station of the Atlanta Hawks and will broadcast all NBA regular season and postseason games played by the Hawks. Steve Holman will return for his 29th year as the Voice of the Hawks. The station will also air pregame and postgame shows and create Hawks programming with on-air basketball talent including Rick Kamla, Sam Mitchell and Dennis Scott.

* In September, new Hawks F/C Gustavo Ayon was named Most Valuable Player of the 2013 FIBA Americas Championship Tournament. Ayon averaged 17.2 points and 8.4 rebounds as he led Mexico to its first FIBA Gold Medal in 35 years.

* The Bakersfield Jam will serve as the NBA Development League affiliate for the Atlanta Hawks. The Jam will also serve as the affiliate for the Los Angeles Clippers, Phoenix Suns, Toronto Raptors and Utah Jazz.
